You will have a snack in the morning. At lunchtime you will have school meal or bring a lunchbox from home. The school meals are very tasty.

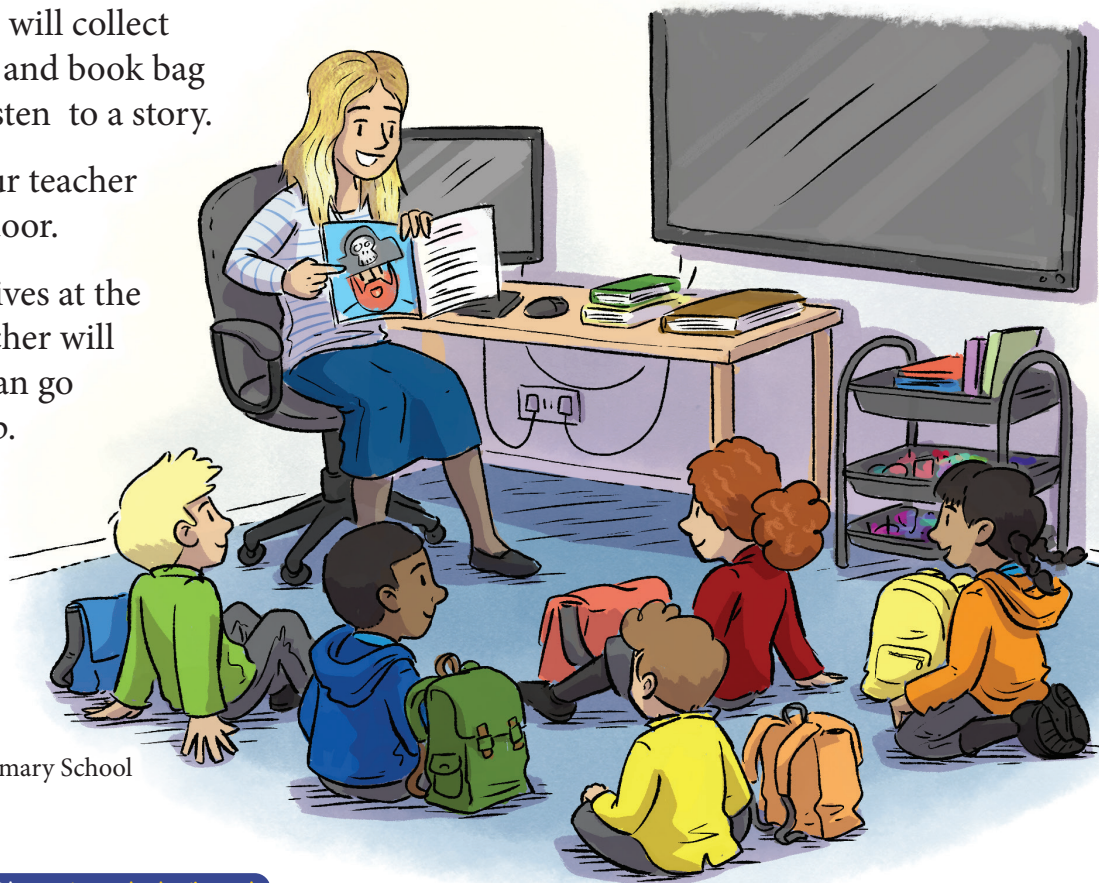
"It's fun sitting eating my lovely dinner with my friends," says Lara.
