Luke and Poppy are collecting their delicious hot school dinners and they will sit with their new friends as they enjoy their lunch.

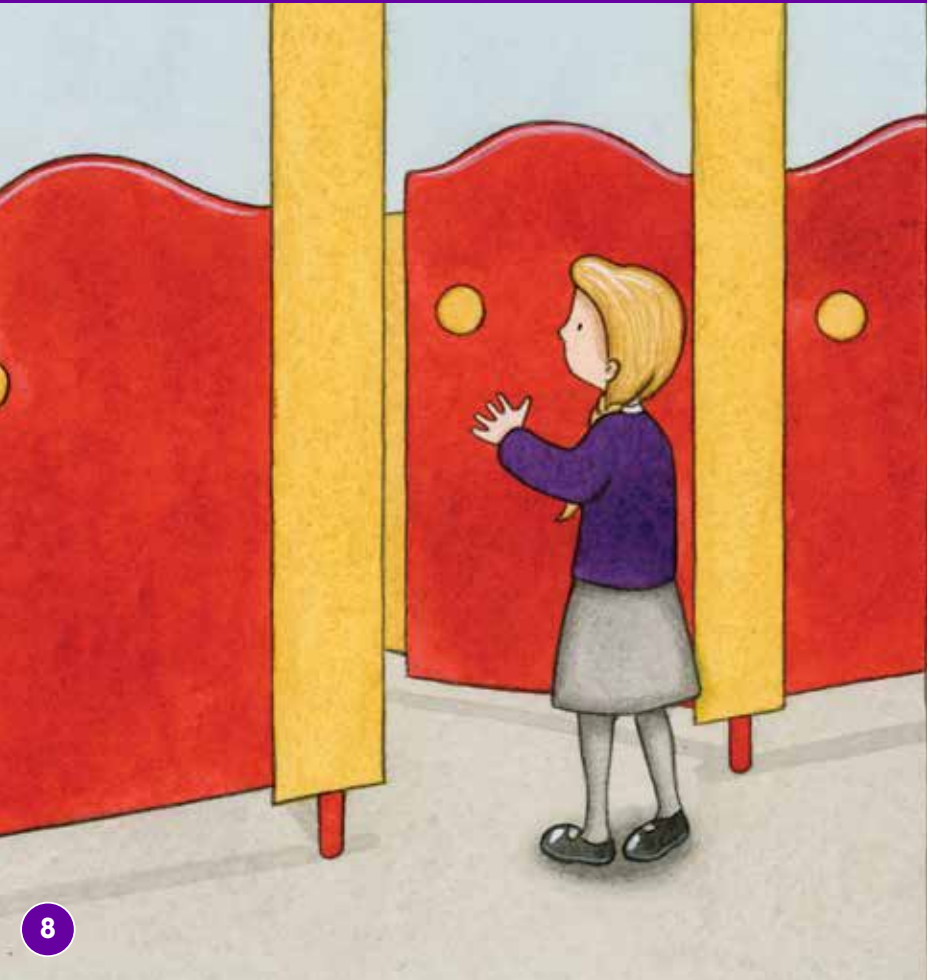


"What is in your lunch box?" asks Anjay, as he and Beth sit and eat their packed lunches.

When school is finished for the day, we sit together on the carpet to listen to a story. You will also talk about the fun things you have been doing and learning during the day.

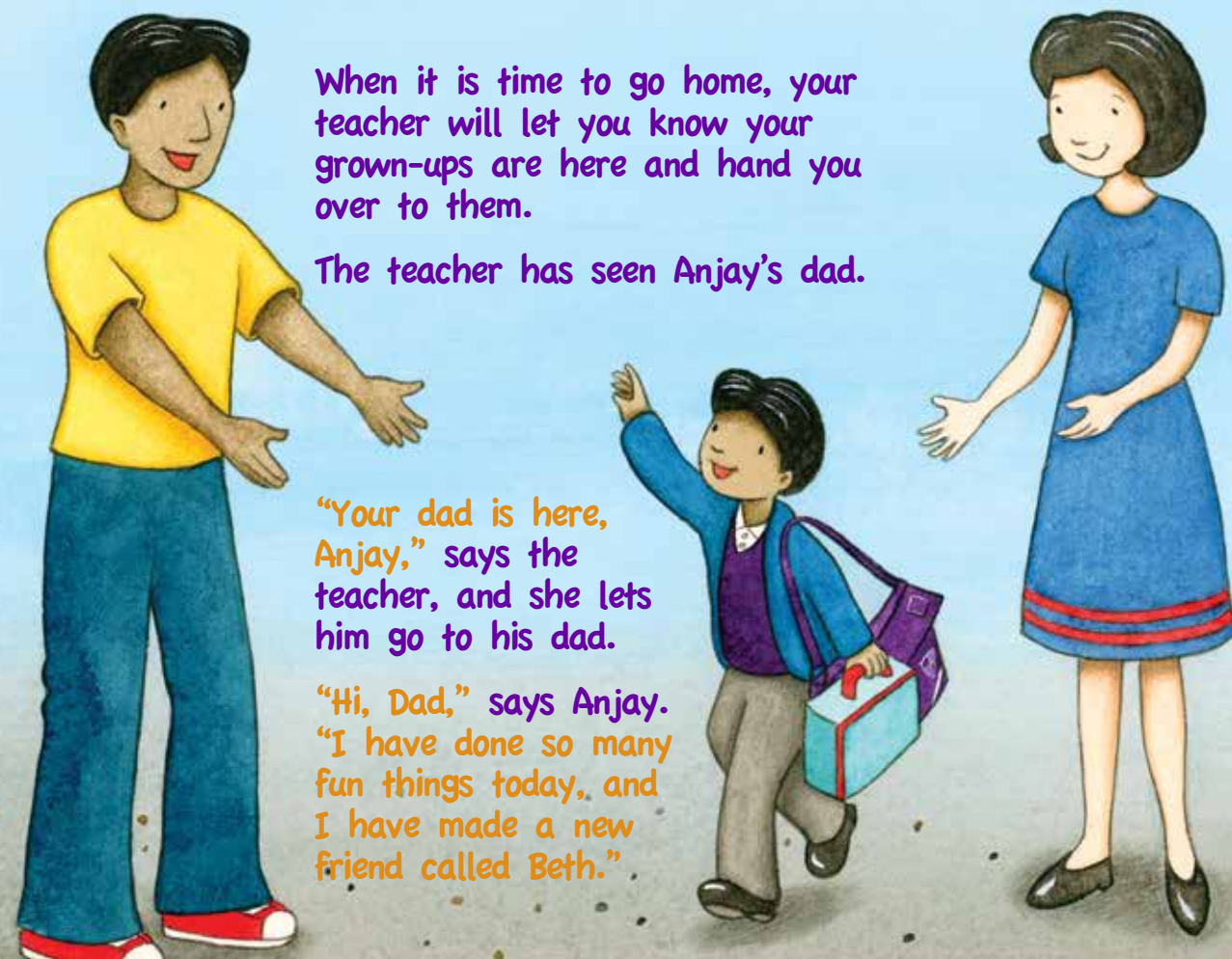


Luke and his friends are listening to a lovely story.

When it is time to go home, your teacher will let you know your grown-ups are here and hand you over to them.

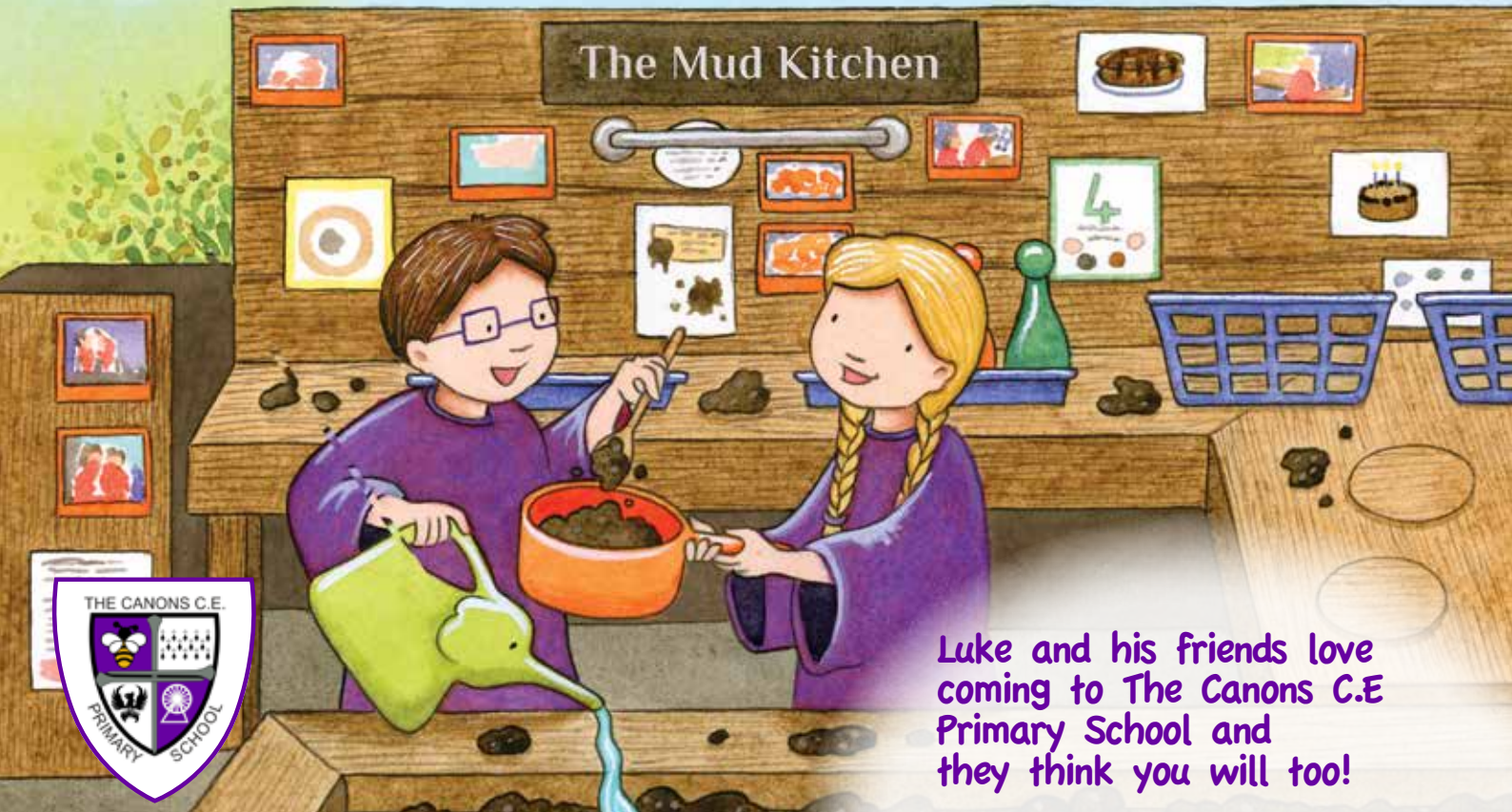
The teacher has seen Anjay's dad.
