Are you excited about coming to school?


How will I make friends?

Myron and his new friends are doing number work with their teacher's help.








During the morning, you will have a snack of fresh fruit to eat, and water or milk to drink. You will take your snack outside to enjoy it at breaktime.

What happens if I need the toilet?


You can just go to the toilet when you need to, but if you are working with your teacher, it is polite to let them know. If you need any help, just tell them.

"Please may I go to the toilet?" asks Zara.


"Yes, of course," says her teacher. "We will see you back here soon."
