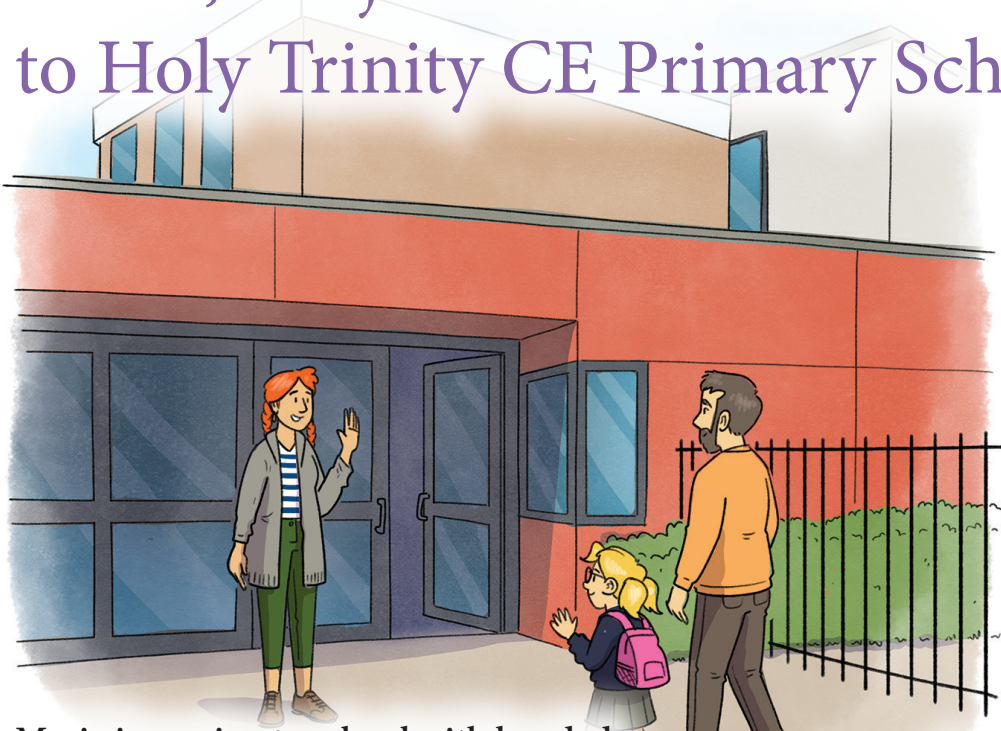


Maria, Benji and Heidi are coming to Holy Trinity CE Primary School
