"Have a lovely day at school!"

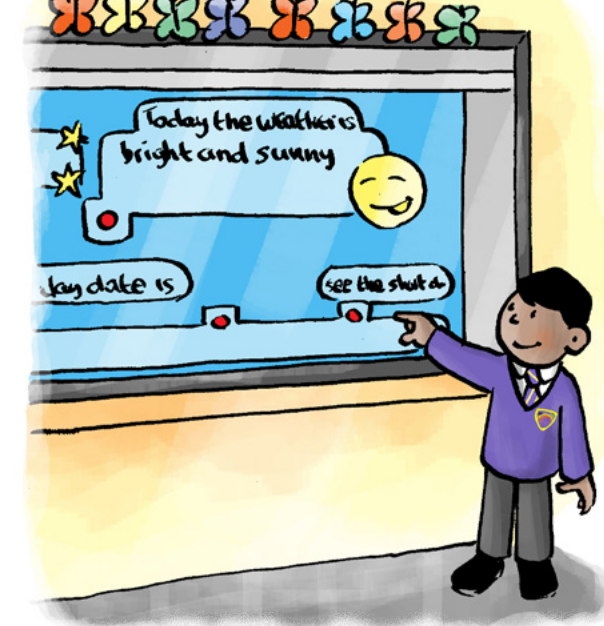
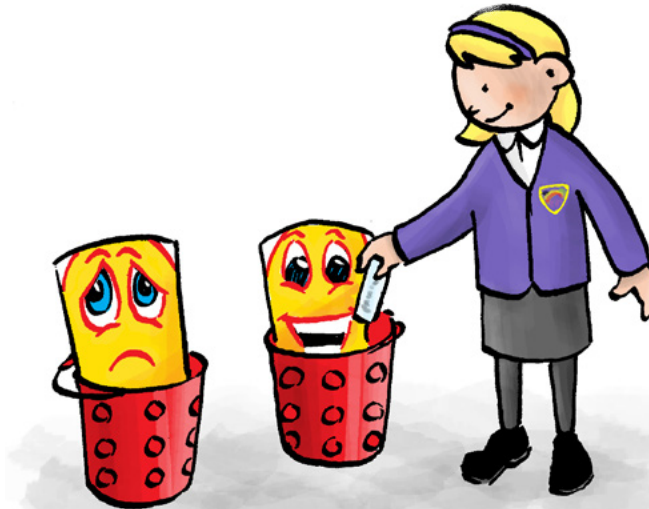
"Bye!" says Femi. She can't wait to start the day!

Then you will sit together to complete the daily calendar on the board and sing our 'Wake Up' song, ready for a day filled with learning.

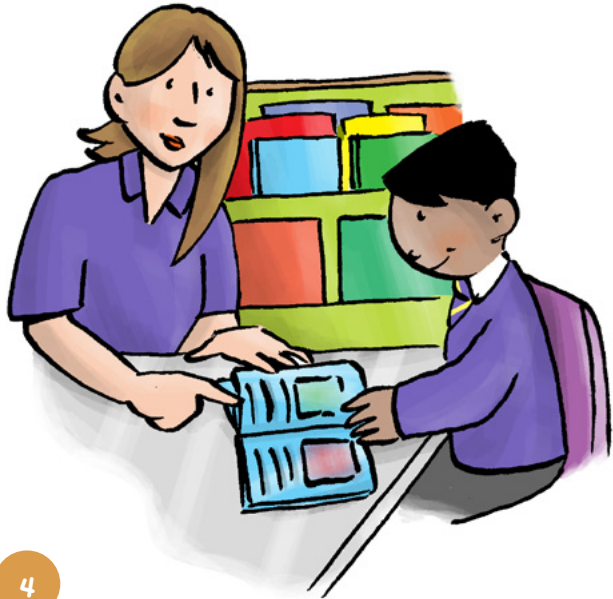
Each day there will be a different activity for you to do in the classroom and some yummy toast to eat too.

## What happens when I am hungry or thirsty?

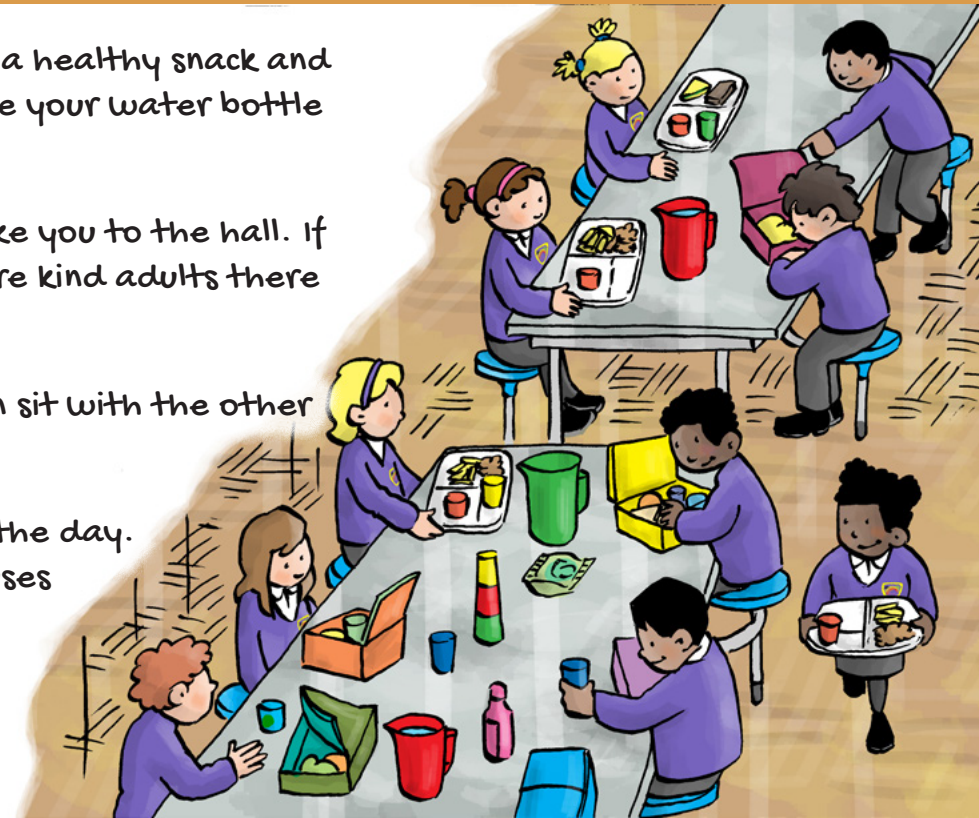
During the morning, you can have a healthy snack and milk whenever you like. You can use your water bottle when you are thirsty.
