How will you help me settle in?


We are very excited to tell you all about us and the wonderful things in store for you at Lympstone C of E Primary School.

## What will I do at Lympstone C of E Primary School?



We also have lovely play equipment for break times and lunchtime, such as trim trail, gym equipment, football goals, netball goals and a ball catcher.


You will love our WOW weeks. where we all work on one project. At the end of the fun week, we will show each other some art or put on a performance for the whole school!

What is your favourite meal?


There are a lot of lovely, kind mid-day supervisors there who will take care of you while you eat.
