Now Cole and Rania are outside on the bikes, racing each other, like Passionate Penny.



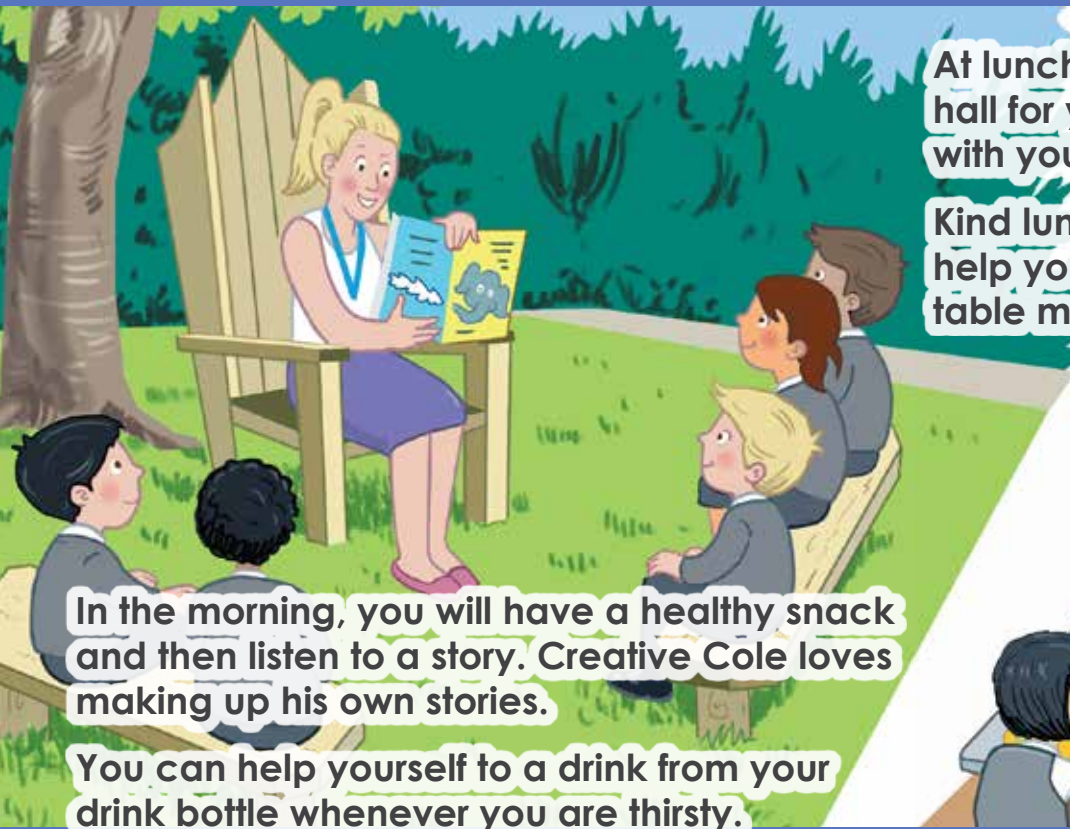
Rania and Eesa are building towers.
