What happens when I come to school?

What happens if I am hungry or thirsty?

If you feel hungry or thirsty, you can help yourself to fruit, milk and water at the snack table. You can also drink from your water bottle whenever you are thirsty.

At lunchtime, after you have washed your hands, your teacher will take you to the hall.



You will line up and collect the meal choice which matches your wristband.

"This looks very tasty," says Tommy.

What happens when I need to go to the toilet?

You can go to the toilet whenever you need to, but if you need to go during carpet time, you must put up your hand to tell your teacher that you need to go.

You will go to the toilet by yourself so your grown-ups will make sure that you have lots of practice before you start school.

Carlo has been to the toilet and remembered to flush. He is now washing his hands carefully with soap and warm water.

**"I'm washing my hands really well,
so I don't spread any germs,"** he says.

If you have an accident or need help, tell your teacher and they will help you. Your grown-ups will leave some spare clothes in school in case you need them.
