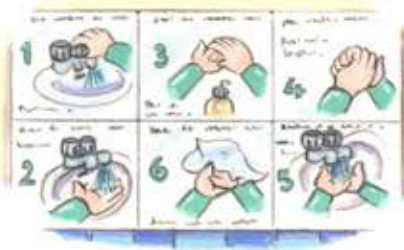


Playing with sand

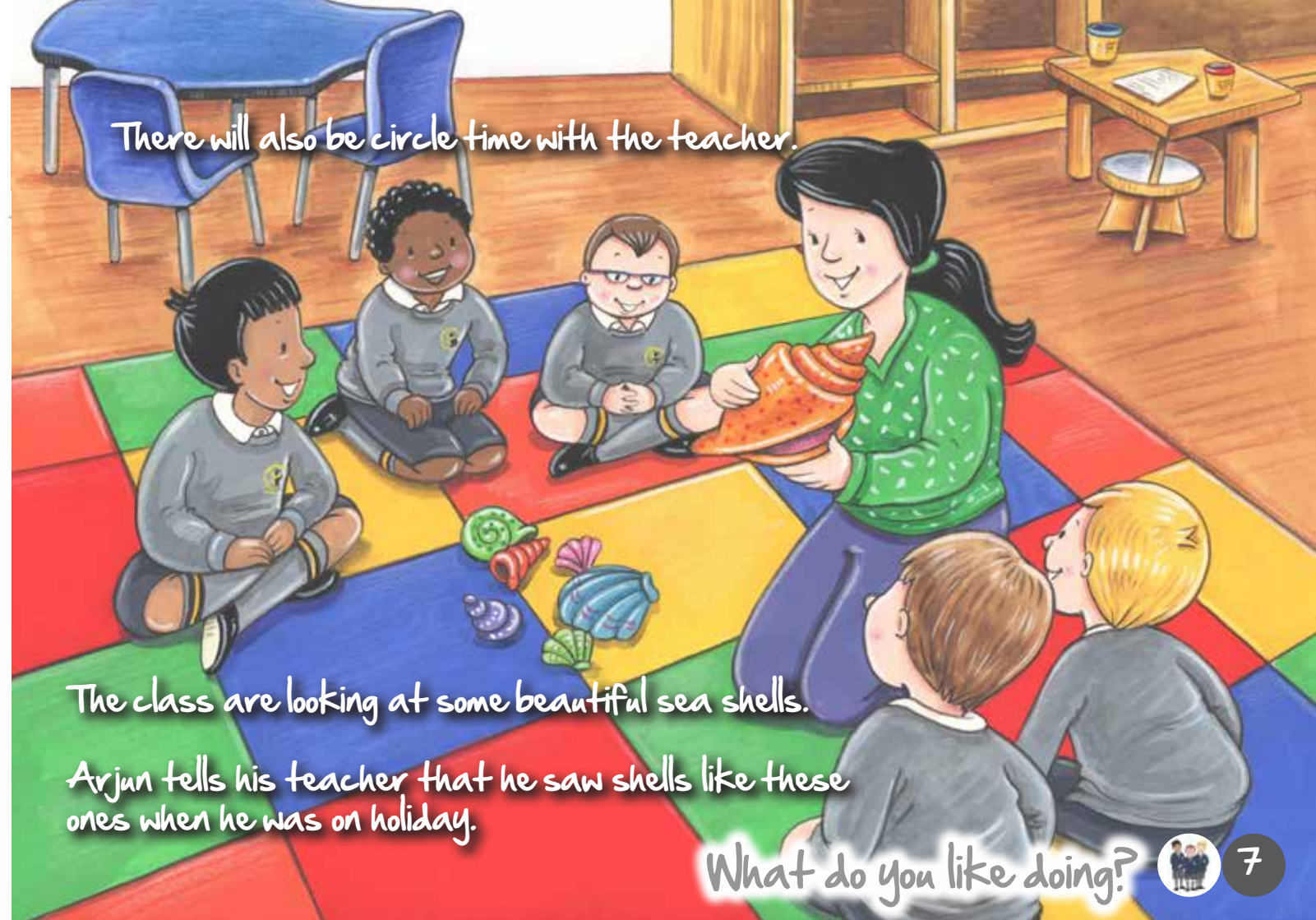
Playing with water

Thomas and Oliver are tucking into some tasty fruit. The boys chat about what they have been doing that morning. They have been so busy, the day is whizzing by.



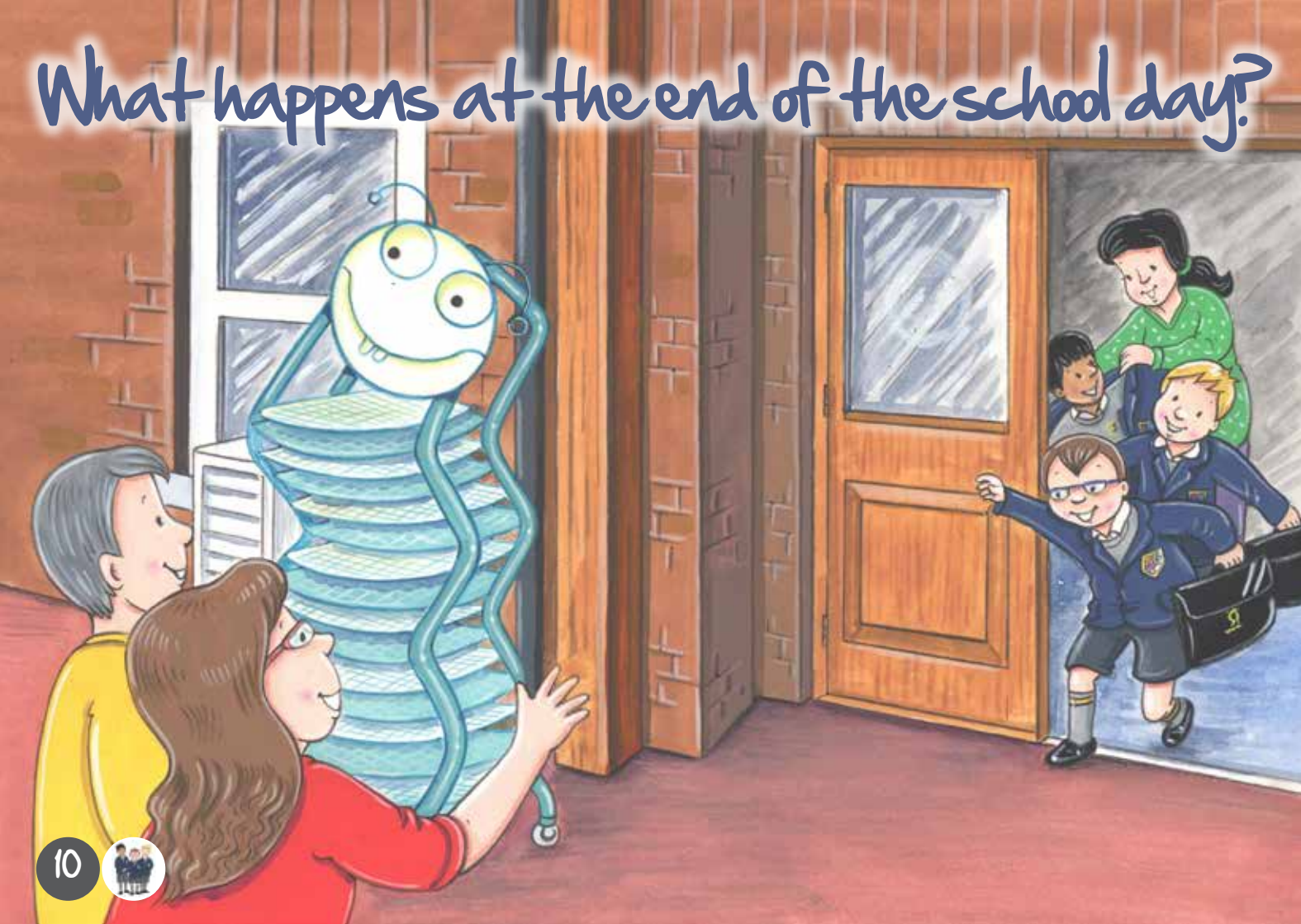
At lunch time you will sit in a family group with children from other classes. A grown-up sits with you too. They will ask you what you want for lunch and bring it to you at your table.
