

### What happens when I get to school?


When you get to school, your grown-ups will bring you into the classroom where your teacher will be waiting to meet you. Your grown-ups will help you get settled and then say goodbye.

Jacob, Zara and Ben think it is great fun learning new things and making new friends.


## What happens if I am hungry or thirsty?

Zara goes to the toilet. When she has finished, she makes sure she flushes to leave the toilet nice and clean for the next child who will use it.




She washes her hands with warm water and soap. She loves the bubbles that help her get her hands really clean. Then Zara dries them and she goes back to her class.
