


## What happens when I get to school?

 Lego, and a home corner with a doll's cot and a pram





"I am going to paint fish in the bright blue sea," says Ella as she sets up her paper on the easel.

# What happens if I am hungry or thirsty?




During the morning, you will have a snack of fresh fruit to eat, and water or milk to drink.

Alex and his new friend Harry are sitting chatting as they enjoy their morning snack.


"I love pears," says Alex.

### What happens if I need the toilet?




You can just go to the toilet when you need to, but if you are working with your teacher, it is polite to let them know. If you need any help, just ask them.

When it is time to go home, you will collect your coat and belongings and get ready to go home.


