



What happens when I get to school?





Are you excited about coming to school?


What will I do in school?

After letting her teacher know, Abbie goes to the toilet.


When she has finished, she will make sure she flushes to leave the toilet nice and clean for the next child who will use it.


When school is finished for the day, you sit together on the carpet to listen to a story. You will also talk about the fun things you have been doing and learning during the day.
