Then you hang up your coat on your coat peg


...put your book bag and water bottle away...

Are you excited about coming to school?


What will I do in school?

Playing house in our home area




What are you looking forward to doing at school?

After letting her teacher know, Abbie goes to the toilet.


When she has finished, she will make sure she flushes to leave the toilet nice and clean for the next child who will use it.
