What happens when I get to school?

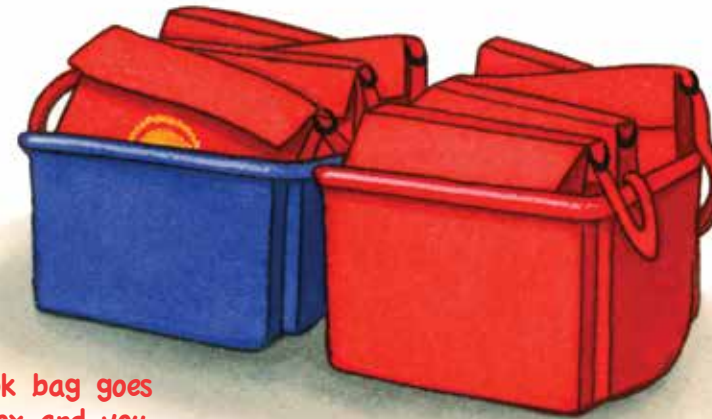
When you get to school, your grown-ups will say goodbye at the school gate where your teacher will be waiting to welcome you into school.



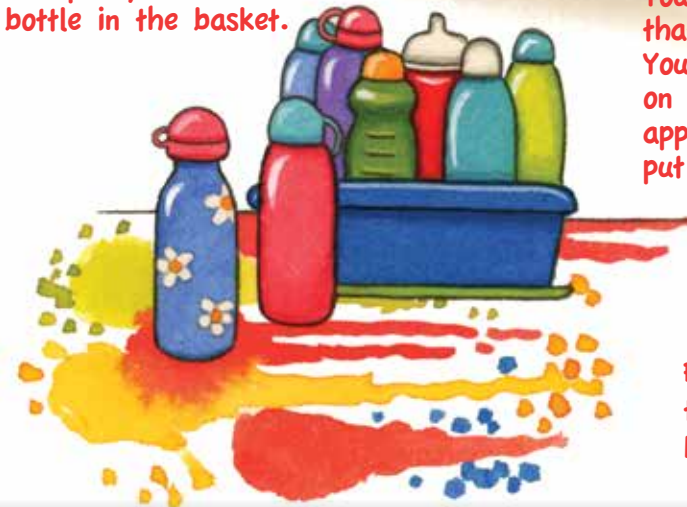
Joseph's grown-ups are waving goodbye as Joseph says hello to his teacher and his new classmates.

You will then register that you are in school. You find your name card on the wall picture of an apple tree and then you put it in the basket.

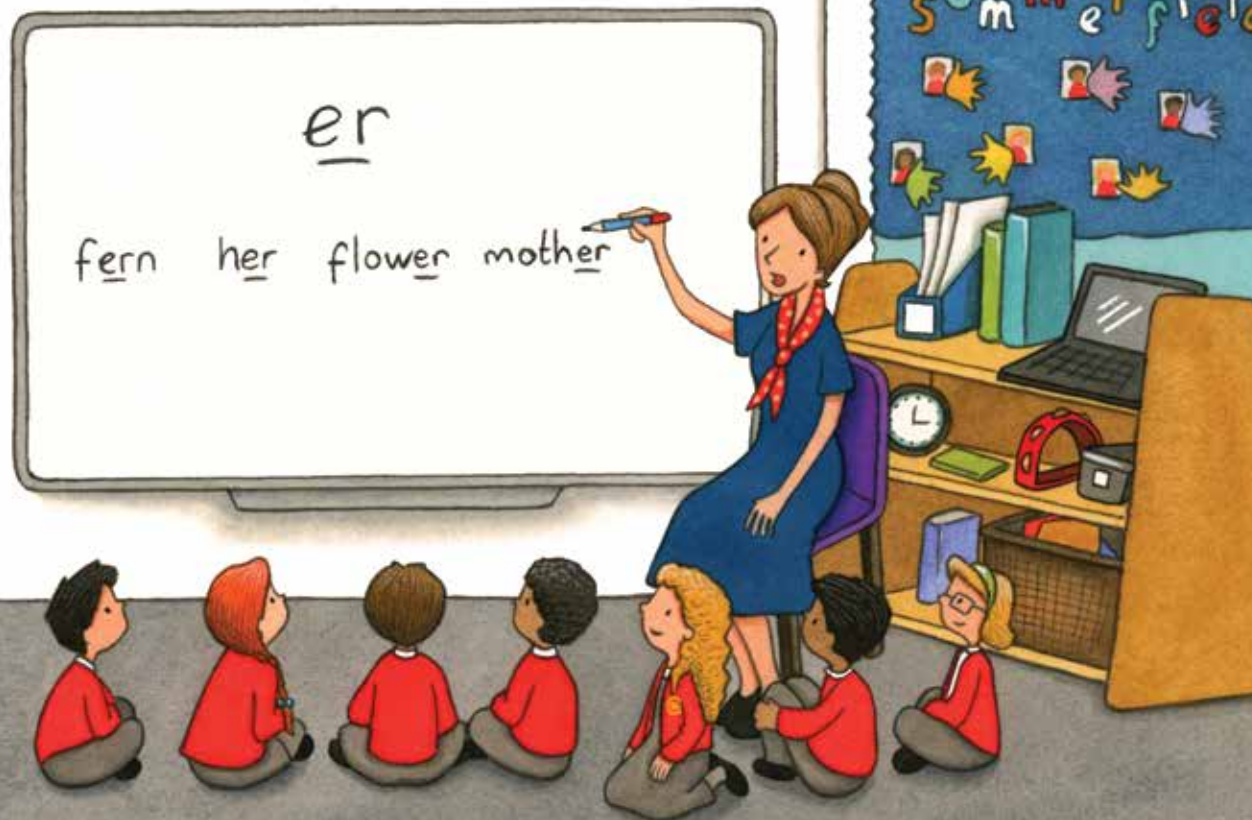


Esther has found her name card on the apple tree picture and she pops it in the basket. Now everyone knows she is in school today!

What will I do in school?

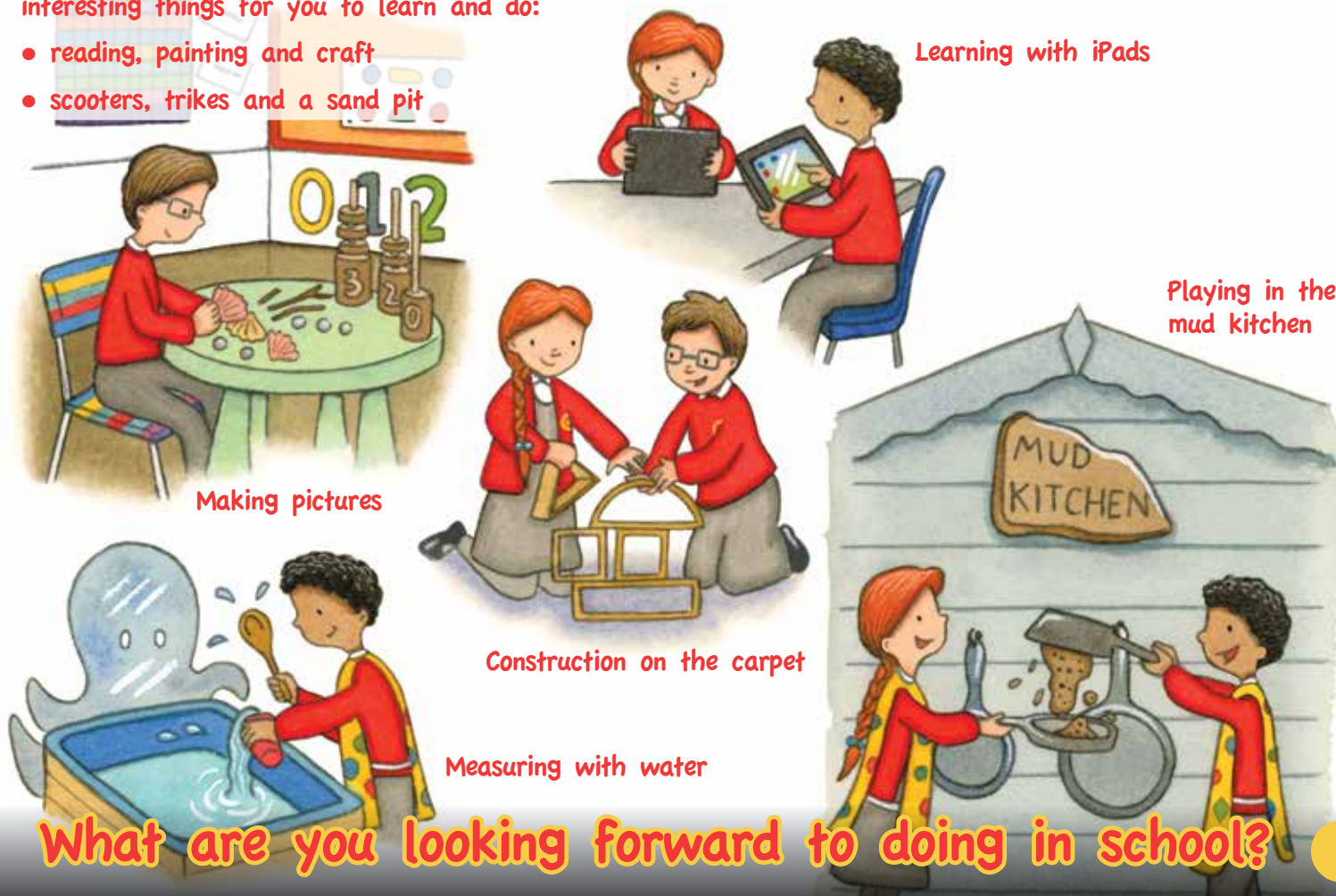
You will start every day with some learning about phonics and maths.

After breaktime, you will have a drink of milk or water when you are back in your classroom.



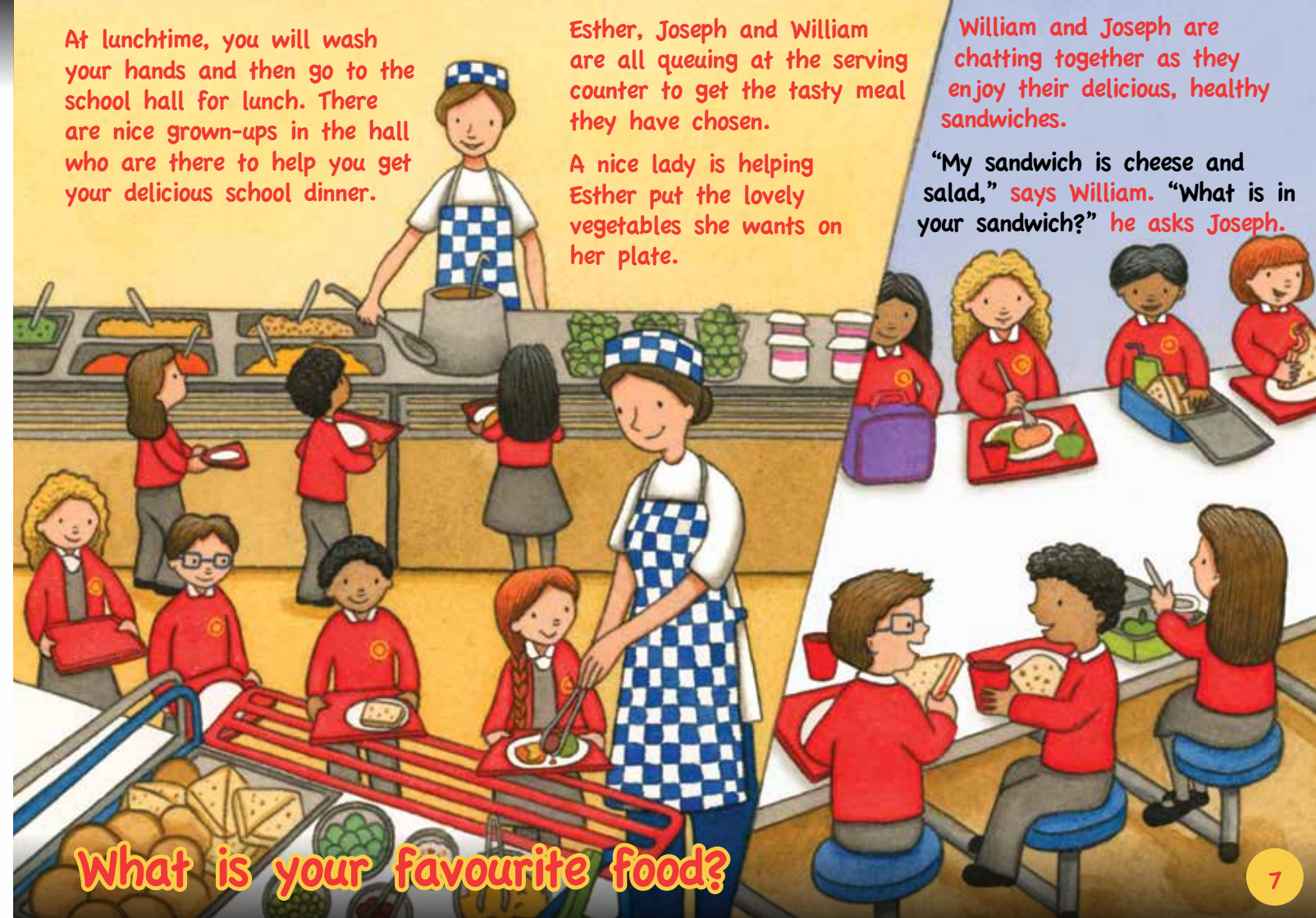
At lunchtime, you will wash your hands and then go to the school hall for lunch. There are nice grown-ups in the hall who are there to help you get your delicious school dinner.
