

## What happens when I come to nursery or P1?

"I love spaghetti," says Anna.




### What happens when I need the toilet?

In P1 the toilets are outside the classroom, so remember to put your hand up and let the teacher know when you need to go.


Don't forget to flush the toilet and leave it nice for the next person to use. After you have been to the toilet wash your hands with soap and water, like Anna is doing.
