
Your teachers will show you where to put your snack, water bottle and book bag. If you have brought a packed lunch from home, they will show you the tub that it will go in.

There are lots of lovely things to do in the classroom and outdoors.


Asha is snuggled up and looking at a book.

Sara and Jacob are painting some pictures.


"I got my hands nice and messy making this picture," Sara says. "But I have washed them and now they are clean."
