How should I get ready for my first day? **Sut ddylwn i baratoi ar gyfer fy niwrnod cyntaf?**

It is important to wear the correct uniform from the first day.

The uniform is as follows:

- Plain black tailored trousers or skirt
- White long or short-sleeved cotton shirt
- School tie to be worn smartly, close to the top button of your shirt or blouse
- Black V-neck jumper/cardigan with school badge
- Plain black shoes/trainers

Your coat should be a dark colour and suitable for the weather. Religious head coverings should be plain black. A jilbab must be black with the school badge.

You will also need to bring your PE kit when required.

You will need to bring a bag every day. It should be a waterproof rucksack that can hold books, an A4 file, and your PE kit.

You can leave your PE kit bag in your tutor room, until you need it.

Top tip: Pack your bag the night before to be ready for school in the morning.

You should bring your pencil case to school every day. It should contain:

- Black pens
- Pencils
- Ruler
- Sharpener and rubber

You will also need to bring a scientific calculator.

School starts at 8.35am. You can arrive any time from 8.20am. On your first day, school staff and prefects will meet you at the main gates and direct you to the canteen for a Welcome Assembly. You will meet your Form Tutor and your buddy prefect, who will welcome you and help you settle in.

After assembly, you will spend time with your Form Tutor and new form group.

During your first week, you will have a series of special lessons to help you settle in and ease any worries you might have. The topics will include:


