'This is my peg," says Ethan.


What will I do in school?


After tidying away, you will sit on the carpet while your teacher takes the register.

Don't worry if you have a toilet accident, just tell your teacher and they will help you. We have a collection of spare clothes in school in case you need them.




How will I make friends?

"Would you like some more tea?" Lily asks Ethan.




Next, Ethan plays with the dressing-up
