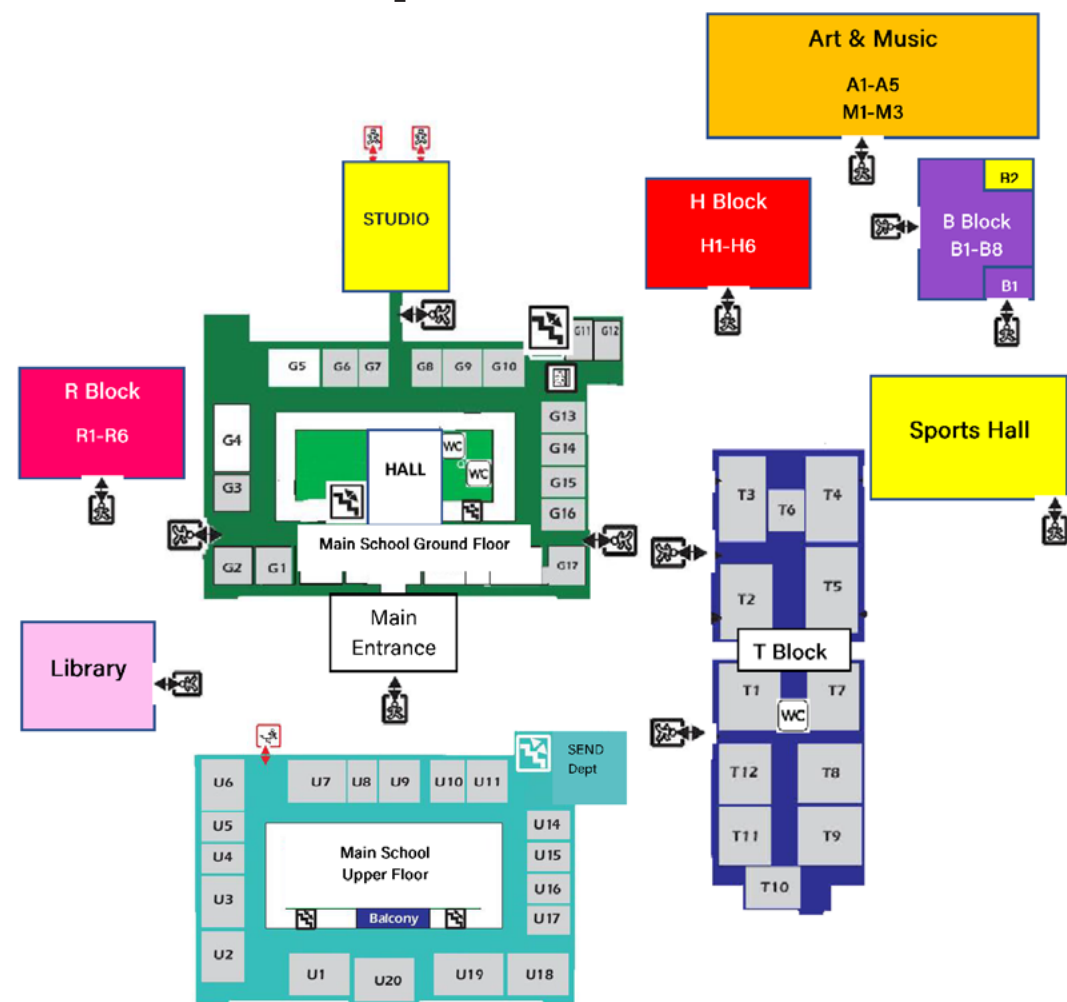
Subject	Room	Description

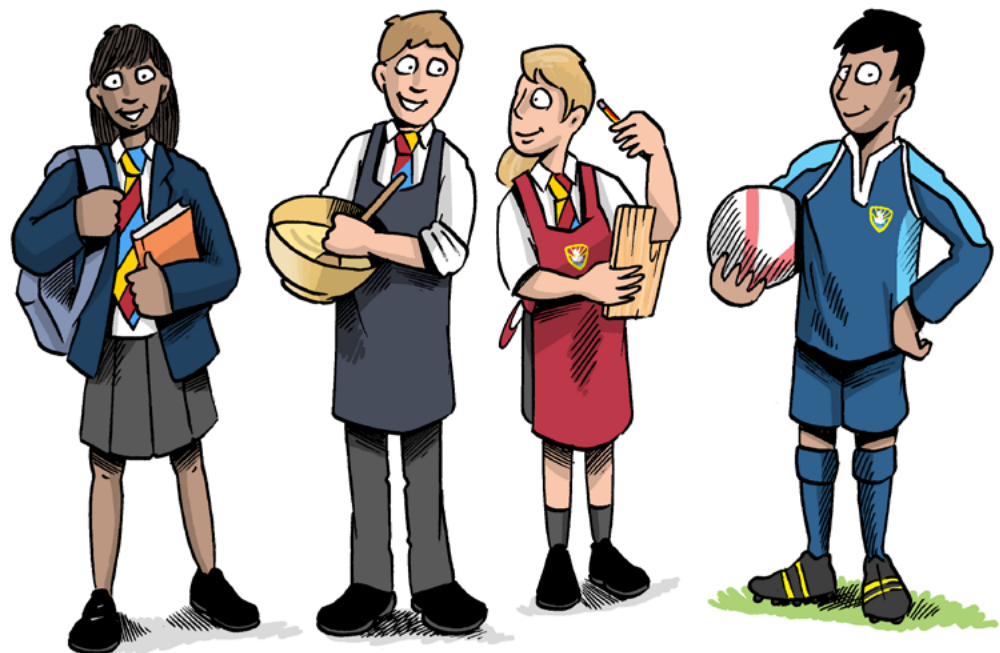




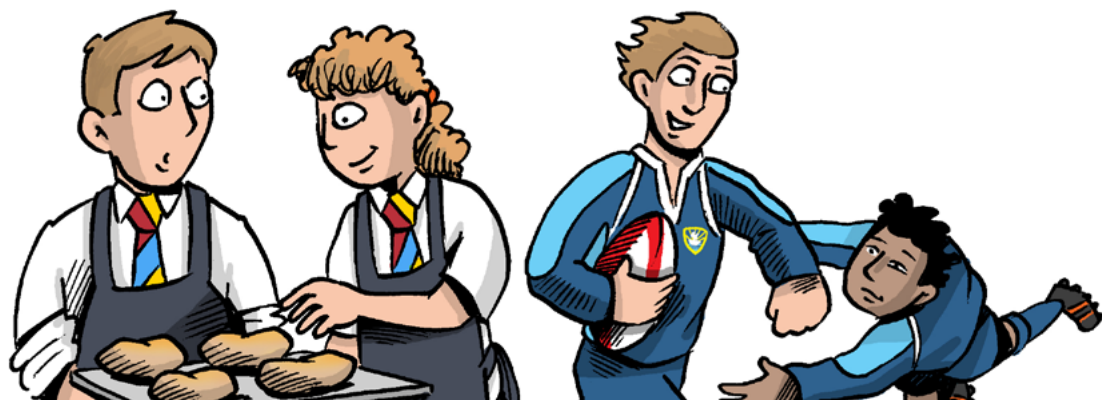
