Afternoon Session 1.25pm to 3.20pm

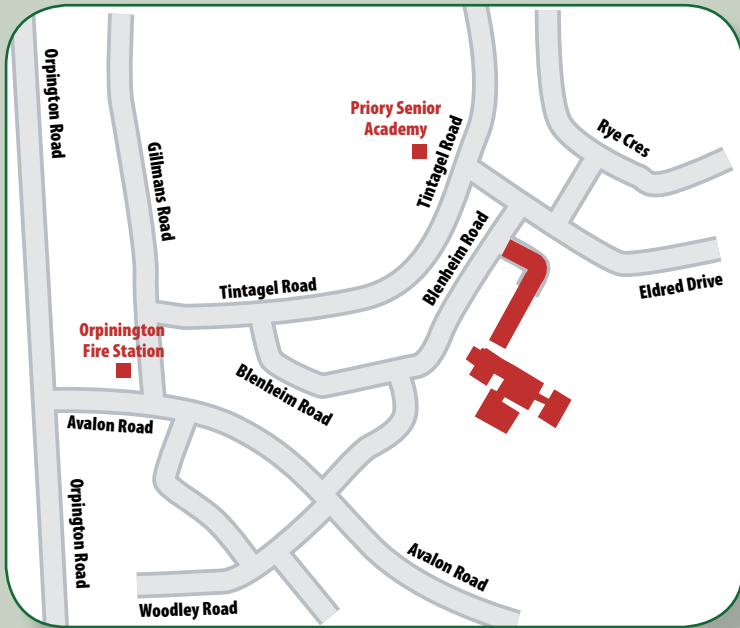
Breakfast Club

Breakfast club runs before school every day from 8am. Children receive a healthy breakfast and are given a wide range of fun activities to get their day off to a great start! Breakfast club is run by Blenheim staff.

Arrivals and departures

Children arrive in school either for Breakfast Club at 8am, or between the hours of 8.45am and 8.55am. If you are late for school please ensure that you accompany your child up the drive and into the office to sign them in.

Please help to keep children safe by not driving into the school grounds and we ask everyone to avoid parking on the yellow zig-zag lines outside of the school, and across neighboring drives.



Uniform

A simple uniform is helpful in establishing good standards of appearance in school and by wearing it children quickly feel part of the community. We ask that all clothing has your child's name on it to ensure that any items that are mislaid can be returned.

Boys:

- Green v neck sweatshirt (with school logo)
- Grey trousers or shorts
- White polo shirt
- Black school shoes

For Girls:

- Grey skirt or pinafore
- White polo shirt
- For summer a green and white checked dress can be worn
- Black shoes.

Free school meals

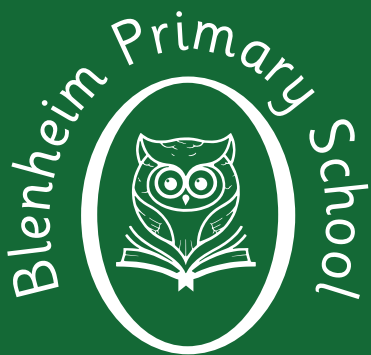
All Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils are entitled to a free school meal every day. If you think your child may be entitled to free school meals from Year 3 onwards please advise the school office who will be able to assist you.

School meals

Each day children have the choice of a main course with meat, a vegetarian option or a jacket potato with filling, along with a salad bar and dessert. The current school menu is always available on the school website. Alternatively, parents are welcome to provide their child with a healthy packed lunch. We consider a healthy packed lunch to consist of only one small biscuit or cake or a packet of low fat, low salt crisps. Please do not include any chocolate, fizzy drinks or sweets.

Healthy snacks and drinks

Under the Fruit in School scheme children are entitled to a piece of fruit each day free of charge. This is given as a playtime snack. Please can you ensure that your children come to school with a labeled water bottle. Sweets, chocolate, chewing gum, etc. are not permitted in school. We are a nut free school.
