We would love to welcome your Year 4 and Year 5 pupils into our school to take part in interactive, hands on sessions in different subject areas:

**Art and ceramics:** Pupils will use clay to sculp model birds. These will be fired in our kiln and then pupils can paint the models to bring them to life!

**French:** we will tailor an afternoon of engaging French activities to suit the level of language of your pupils. For example, exploring how to describe the colour and size of the planets.

**Music:** Session 1: Practical. Pupils will learn the techniques to chair drum along with backing tracks followed by an introduction to the Ukulele. Pupils will also develop their confidence to sing. Session 2: This will be ICT based. Pupils will use the mixcraft software to create their own pieces of music.

Science: A tailored challenge for your current curriculum based on investigative approach, relevant to science in the real world.



**English:** Pupils will read, listen to and perform poetry and use their reading as a stimulus to help them craft their own writing. Together, we will create a poetry anthology.

**Sport:** Pupils can take part in a range of team sports ranging from the traditional to the more obscure. Pupils can also have sessions on our climbing wall.

**Technology:** Pupils will use learn to use the workshop tools and equipment to cut and combined natural wood to create either; block heads made out of recycled materials or a wooden pencil holder.
