Chloe and Rafael put their reading folders and water bottles away in the boxes. Then the children will find their photos to put onto the register frame to show they are in school.










What will I do there?



Emily, Chloe and Rafael love visiting our chickens.


Rafael says, "I think this one is saying, 'Please feed me'!"

Before the children have something to eat, everyone washes their hands so they are nice and clean.



What if I need the toilet?


"I'm glad I practised going to the toilet by myself before I started reception," says Harry. If he has an accident, one of the teachers will help him to

Which one would you choose?


