Your teacher will lay out some fun activities, like colouring and reading books, for you to start off your day with.






## What happens if I need the toilet?

When you need to go to the toilet, just tell your teacher. You will go to the toilet by yourself but if you need help, just ask your teacher and they will help.


The toilets are at the end of the corridor, so they are close to the classrooms. Your teacher will show you where they are when you come to school.

Sometimes you will listen to a story. Sometimes you will sit in a 'community circle' with your friends and you can talk about your news, what you have been doing or things that are important to you.


> Sometimes you will have theatre time, where you can act out a story you have made up. Your friends can join in too!
