- Moscow hosted the 1980 Summer Olympic Games and the first World Youth Games in 1998.
- The Moscow Armoury, treasury of the Russian Tsars, has a unique collection of state regalia, thrones, carriages, coronation dresses and ten of the world-famous Faberge eggs.
- As the capital of Russia, Moscow is home to many world heritage sites, including: the Kremlin, Red Square, Kolomenskoye Palace and Novodevichy Convent.
- The Moscow Metro, which was opened in 1935, is famous for its elegant architecture with art, murals, mosaics and elaborate chandeliers. It boasts a total of 182 stations and Europe's longest escalator in Park Pobedy.
