- *Nairobi is Kenya's capital city. It came into existence in 1899 when it was founded as a railway depot by the British.*
- *Nairobi is located in south-central Kenya, 140 kilometres south of the equator.*
- *Traditional Kenyan meals consist of barbequed meats and beans. Rice, fried doughs, ugali (a cornmeal porridge), yams and fruits are also often served.*
- *Nairobi National Park is home to a large herd of zebra and many other wild animals, including lions. It's only 20 minutes away from the centre of the city.*
