Facilities

We have good facilities both inside and outside the school. Our outside areas include a grassed area, as well as three separate playgrounds and fixed playground equipment. Internally we have a modern hall, a library and several small group rooms. Each classroom is equipped with an interactive whiteboard and a laptop for every pupil. We have a leafy outdoor classroom and beds for pupils to grow fruit and vegetables all year round.





Music

There are weekly music lessons. All pupils learn to play the violin in year 4. We also offer 1:1 lessons for piano for KS1 & 2. We have weekly singing assemblies and there is also a school choir.

Trips

Trips and visits are an important aspect of learning and something children always remember. Previous trips have included:

Additionally, we arrange visits to the school by theatre groups, professional singers, artists, authors and musicians. In Year 6 the children have the opportunity to go on week-long residential trip.
