Adam and Charlotte Schraibman live in Lamerton with their son Gabriel, 12 and daughter Sissy, 7.

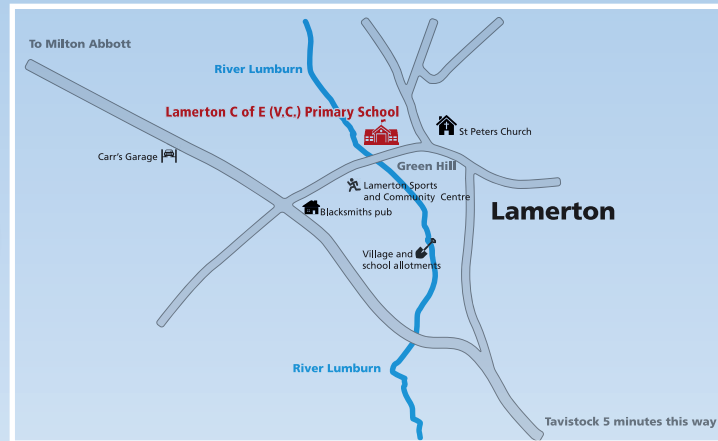
Successes:

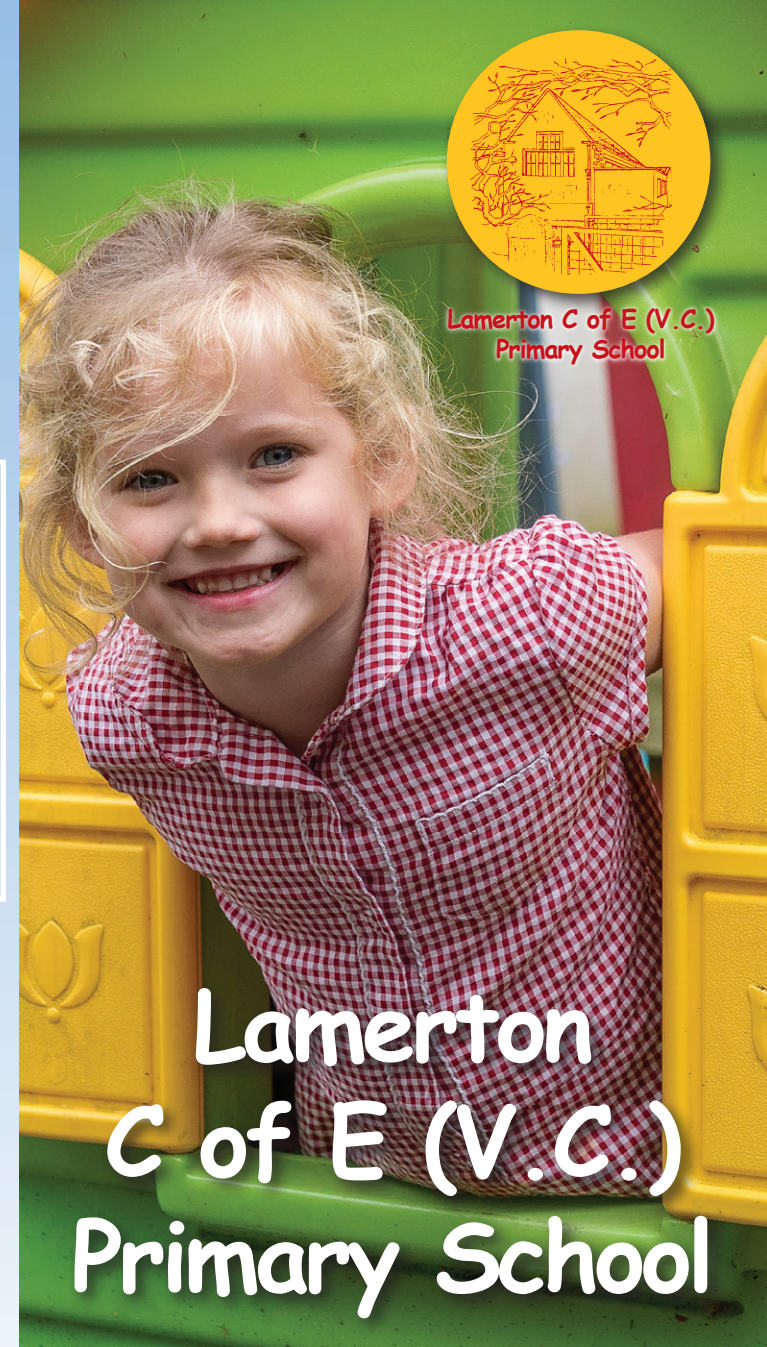

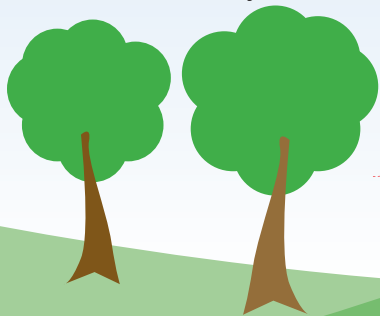
