
Lucie, Miles and Lydia are coming to Fatfield Academy

"Hello, Lucie and Miles. I'm so pleased to meet you. We have lots of fun things to do today," says the teacher.




If you have brought a lunch box, you will also put that under your peg.

Lucie is putting her water bottle on the trolley.


Then you will go to the cloakroom to hang your coat and bag on the peg with your name on it.

What are you looking forward to doing in school?


What happens if I am hungry or thirsty?
