First of all, you will go to your group room for focused learning. You and some friends will do an activity with your teacher which is linked to a topic you are learning.

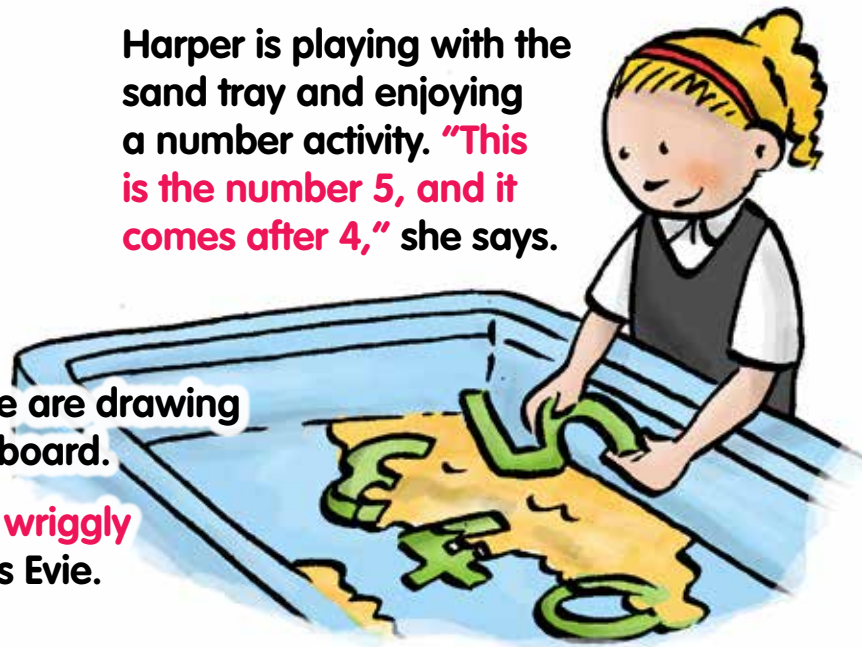


Solly and Evie are drawing on the whiteboard.

## What happens if I am hungry or thirsty?

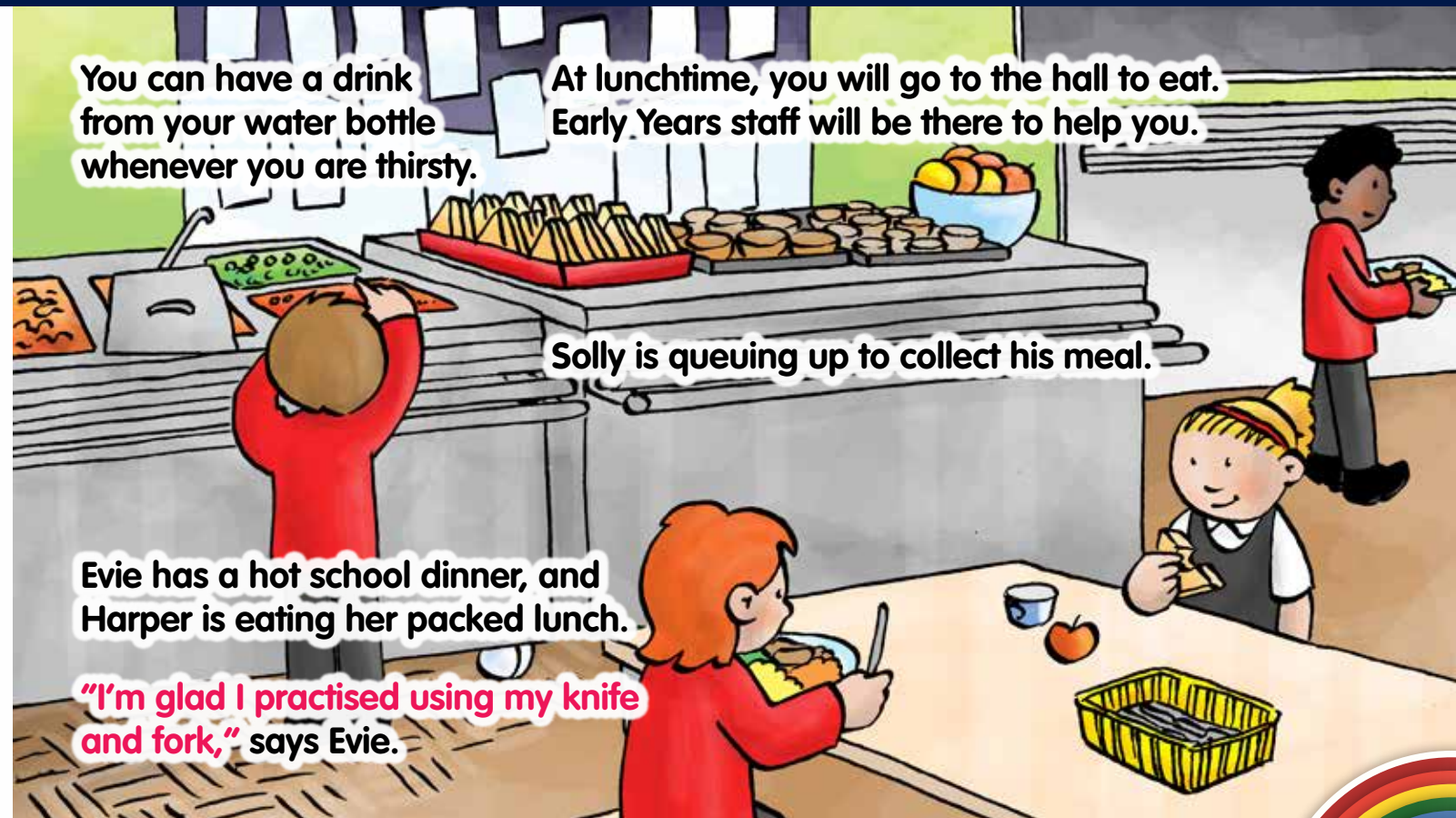
You can have a drink from your water bottle whenever you are thirsty.
