What happens when I get to Pre-School or Reception?



Your teacher will be at the door to meet you when you come into school. You will say "goodbye" to your grown-ups at the door, but they can come with you into the classroom if you are feeling a bit nervous when you start.

What happens if I am hungry or thirsty?

You will have a healthy snack during snack time and sit on the mat or at the table to eat it. You can have a drink of milk or water.

Pre-School children who are in school at lunchtime will bring in a lunch box and eat with their friends in their classroom.

If you are in Reception, you will go to the Hall and have your lunch before the older children. Your teachers will take you to the Hall and there will be kind adults there who will look after you when you have your lunch.

Zane is enjoying his meal.

"I love fish and chips. This is my favourite," he says. Everyone is kind and helpful to each other and uses their cutlery nicely.

After lunch, you can play in the Key Stage 1 playground.

What happens if I need the toilet?

The toilets are in a room in your classroom, so they are easy to get to. Everything is just the right size for you as well.

If you are doing an activity by yourself or with your friends, you can just go. If you are working with a teacher, it is polite to let them know that you need the toilet by putting your hand up.

You will go to the toilet by yourself, but if you need help, just let your teacher know.

"I am glad that I practised going to the toilet all by myself. I feel very grown-up," says Seb to himself.

He has remembered to flush, and he is washing his hands with soap and water.
