


#### What happens when I get to school?

# What happens if I am hungry or thirsty?



Emily has chosen a lovely green apple and she offers it to Jaffar to eat.


"Try this," Emily says.

When school is finished for the day, you gather on the carpet to listen to a story.




The teacher is reading a lovely story about some children playing in a park full of trees and flowers.
