


What happens when I come to school?

In the morning, your grown-ups will make sure that you eat your breakfast so you have lots of energy for school.

"I'm thirsty too," says Layla.


Most children like to have their snack with their friends.

Everyone uses good table manners, which means that we are kind and helpful to each other and use our knives and forks when we eat.




"Thank you for bringing me my lunch," Omar says to the adult.

What if I need the toilet?






What happens at the end of the school day?

Then you will sit on the carpet for story time and songs.




Then it is time to go home. You will collect your coats and belongings and sit at your table. Your grownups will be waiting outside in the playground.
