book bag in the box.




What happens if I am hungry or thirsty?



You can have a snack at any time during the morning. You can have fruit to eat and water or milk to drink. Fruit is delicious, and your teacher will encourage you to try the fruit each


Harry is drinking his milk as Oliver and Daisy choose the fruit they want to eat.

"Try the oranges, they are so juicy and sweet," Oliver says to Daisy.




What do you like to do when playing outside at lunch time?

Oliver goes to the toilet.


When he has finished, he makes sure he flushes to leave the toilet nice and clean for the next child who will use it.


