


What DO I WEAR FOR MY FIRST DAY?

We expect everyone to look smart and wear the correct uniform from their very first day with us.

Take your coat off when you come into the school building.

Your coach will check that you are wearing the uniform regularly.

What WILL I NEED FOR MY FIRST DAY?

You will need to bring the following equipment with you every day:

- Black or blue ballpoint pen (and a spare)
- Pencil
- Pencil sharpener
- Eraser
- Red pen
- Ruler 30cm

Maths:

- Compass
- Protractor
- · Scientific calculator

We will give you a Personal Organiser on your first day and you will need to bring this with you every day as well as is it a very important part of your school life. You will also need to bring an apron for Technology lessons.

Any text books or specialised equipment will be loaned to you but you will need to look after them and pay if you damage or lose them.

Don't forget to switch your mobile phone off and put it in the bottom of your bag when you arrive at school.



Top Tip

Make sure you have breakfast every day.



Pack your bag the night before and check it against your timetable so you don't forget anything!

What WILL YOU EXPECT FROM ME?

We value hard work, perseverance, courtesy, service to others and honesty and tolerance.

We expect everyone at Allerton High to follow these values.

We also have a positive behaviour policy at school. This will help you to understand the rules of the classroom (which will be similar to the rules in primary school). We will explain more about this on your first day.

COACH AND COACHING GROUP

You will be a member of a coaching group which is led by a coach. You will see them most days during coaching sessions. They will help and support you as well as check that you are keeping on track with your studies.

REWARDS

When you have shown a positive attitude to learning in lessons, you will receive **achievement points**. You can trade these for rewards. Examples of rewards include shop vouchers and trips, depending on how many electronic stamps you earn.



Treat people the way you want to be treated and try and make a good impression.

What ELSE DO I NEED TO THINK ABOUT FOR MY FIRST DAY?

- Arrive on time think about your journey before your first day
- Bring lunch money or make sure your online account has some money in it. (Ask your parents/carers to sort this out).
- Speak to at least three other students that you don't know already. It will really help with making new friends.

activities and clubs are a fantastic way to meet people who like the same things and to make new friends




WHAT IF I NEED HELP?

You will also receive homework most days. Log it in your Personal Organiser when you get it so you can keep track of it.


You will need to be organised, so you always hand your homework in when it's due, to a standard you are proud of and allow time for any out-of-school activities.
