#### Equipment




#### What happens on the first day?

## What happens in a school day?



In Upper School, you are expected to arrive between 7.30 and 7.55am, ready for the school day, which starts at 8.00am.

The school day ends at 3.00pm and buses leave at 3.30pm.

Some co-curricular activities will run after school.

Each day has four periods of teaching, and you will move between classes for each lesson. We allow time for you to move from class to class, and you will have lots of help finding your way around. You will soon know where everything is!

#### Food

You can bring lunch from home or get something from our cafeteria. There is a fantastic range of food available, such as snacks, sandwiches, salads and main courses.

### What subjects will I study?

You will follow the International Baccalaureate curriculum.

You will study Languages (including Chinese), History, Geography, Sciences, Mathematics, Arts, Design, and Physical and Health Education.


We use English as our primary language, but we will give you lots of support if English is not your first language.
