Some children have allergies, so we do not allow any food containing nuts in school or let anyone share their food.

Everyone eats in the classroom together.

"I love peanut butter sandwiches," says Aryan.
"But I know I can't have them at school."

"Yes, because I have a nut allergy," says Bruno.

Teachers will be there to look after you and help while you are eating. Then you get to go outside to play.



The toilets are outside the classroom, so you need to allow time to get there.

Remember to ask your teacher when you need to go.

Aryan is going to the toilet.

"Everything is just the right size for me!" he says.

After Aryan has finished and flushed, he washes his hands with soap and water and dries them. This helps prevent germs spreading.
