New school building inaugurated

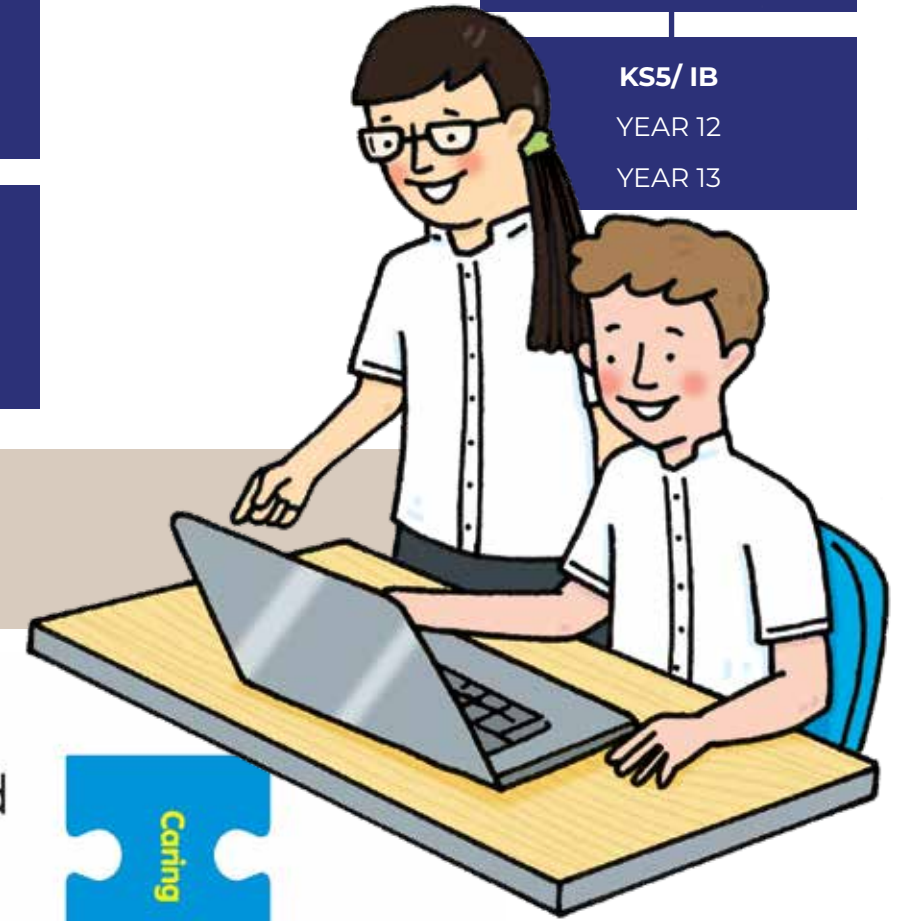
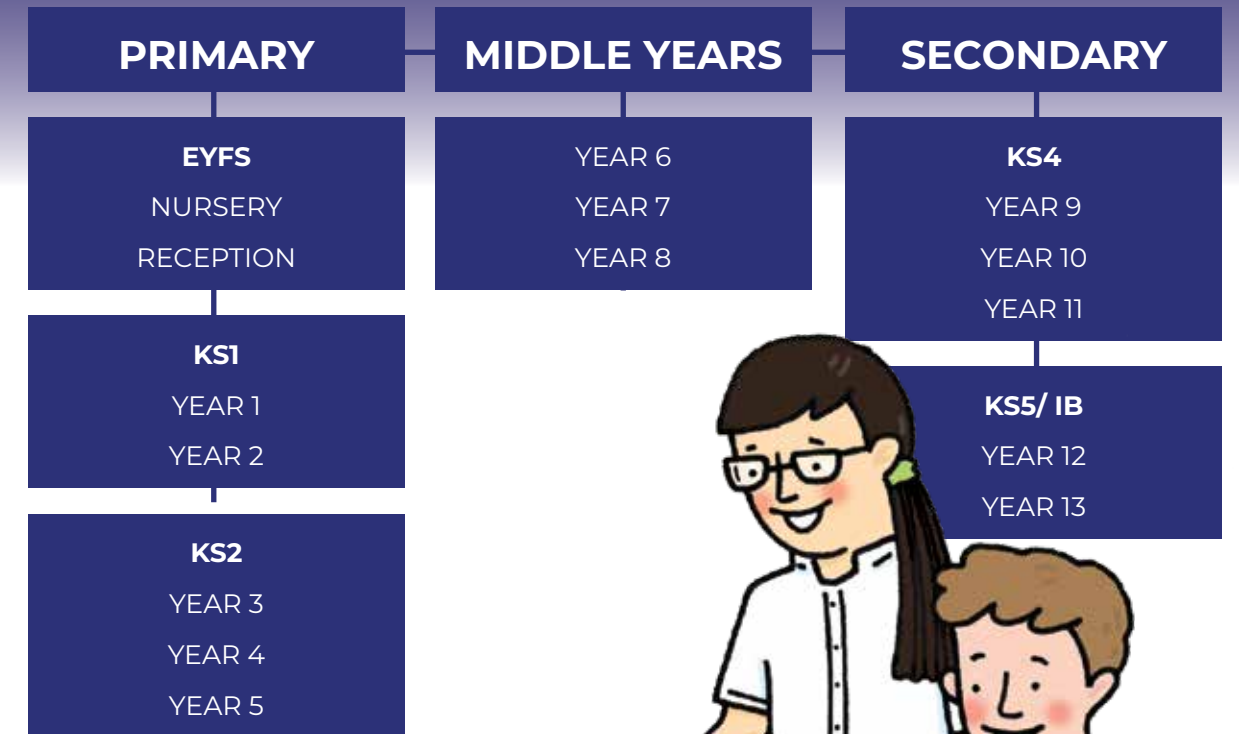

THE SCHOOL DAY

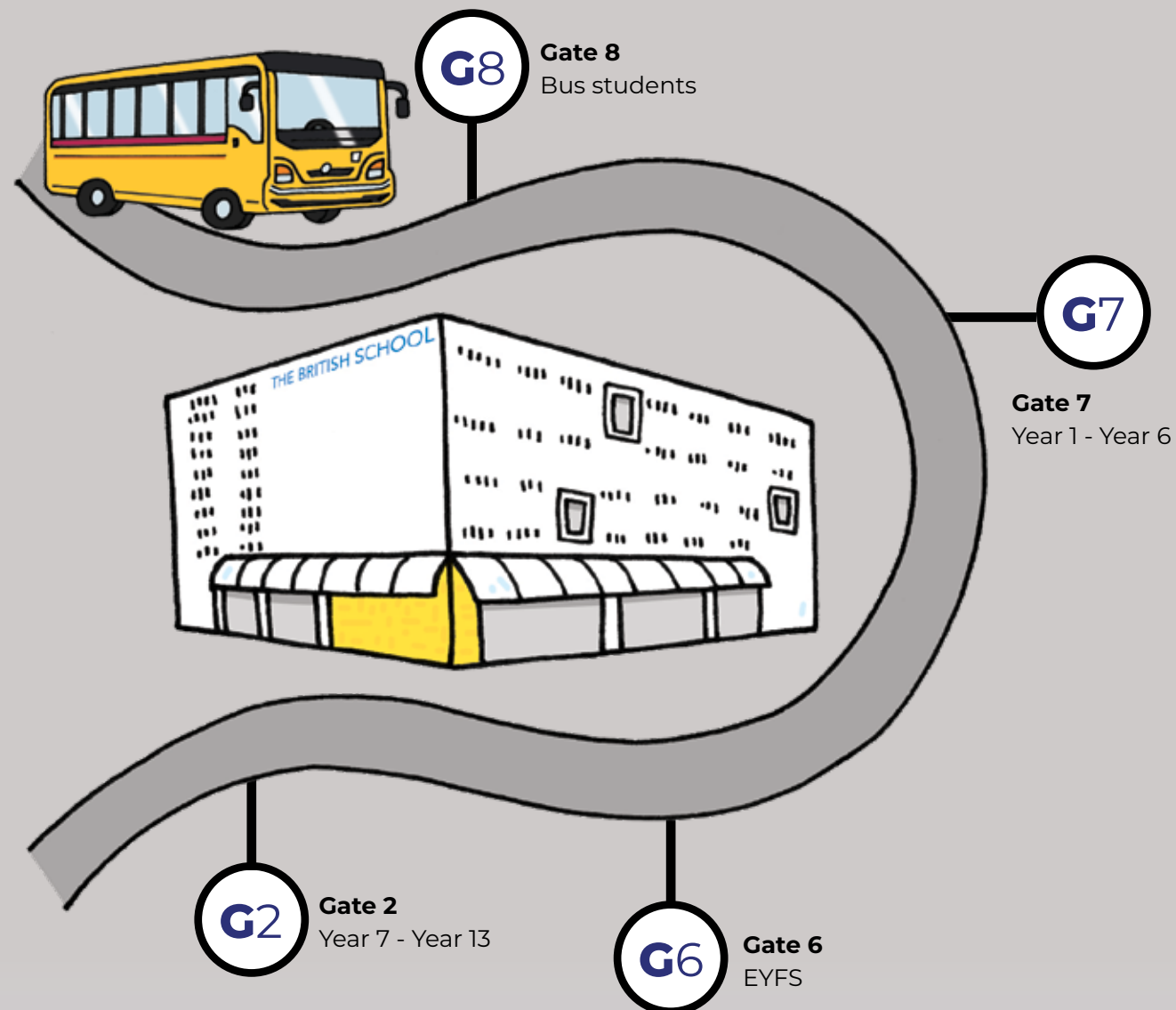
WHAT DOES THE SCHOOL DAY LOOK LIKE?

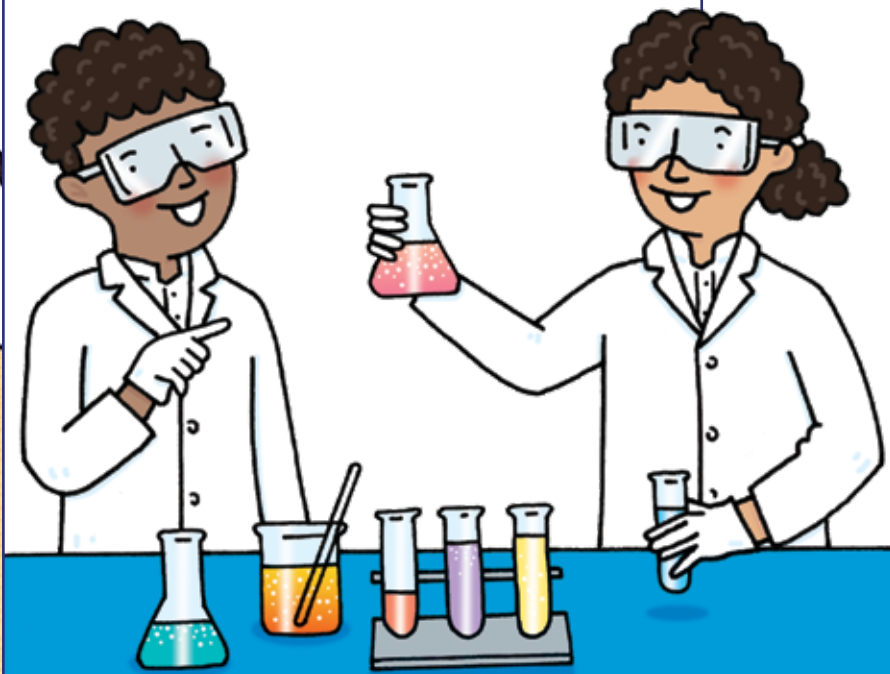
