




## How will Dean Trust Wigan help me get ready to come to secondary school?

We have high standards for everyone at Dean Trust Wigan.


We expect you to wear the full, correct uniform.

## What happens on my first day at Dean Trust Wigan?




Your new term will start a day before the rest of the school so you can get settled in when the school is less busy.

#### What happens in a school day?



The school day has 6 lessons which are 50 minutes long. There is also a break and lunchtime.
