You can come to school in your PE kit if you have PE that day.

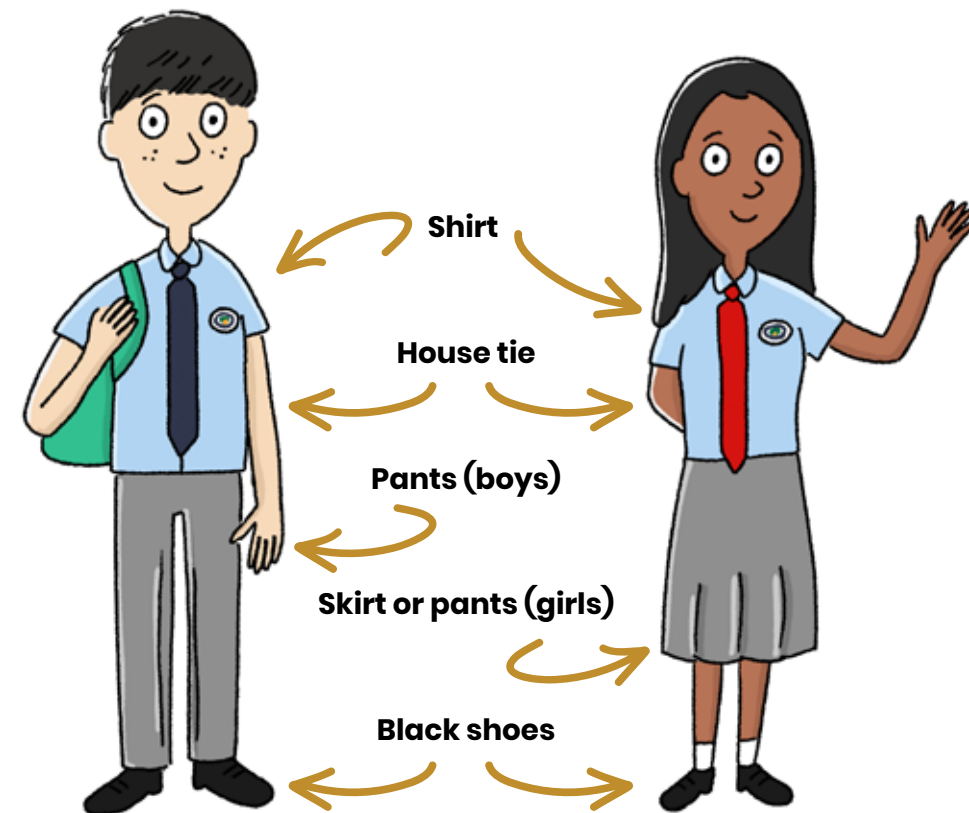
What equipment will I need?

What else can I do in Lower Secondary?

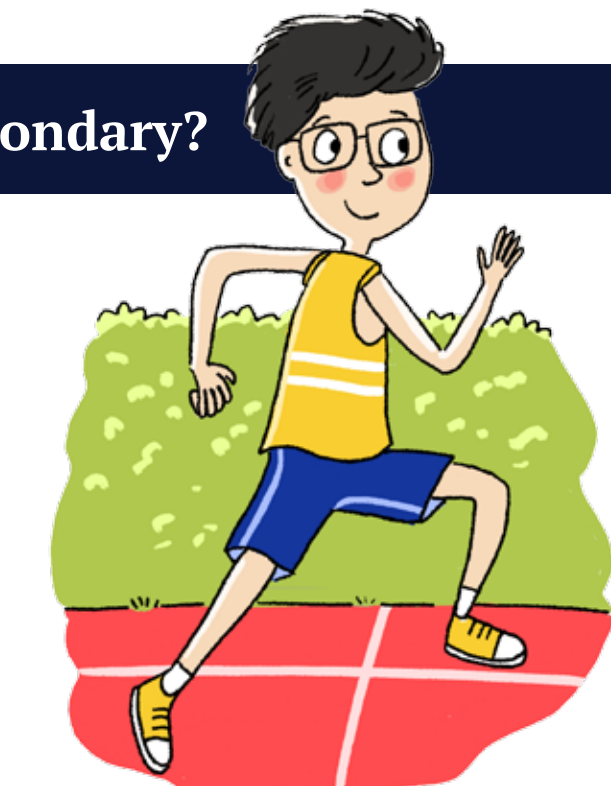
Co-curricular activities
