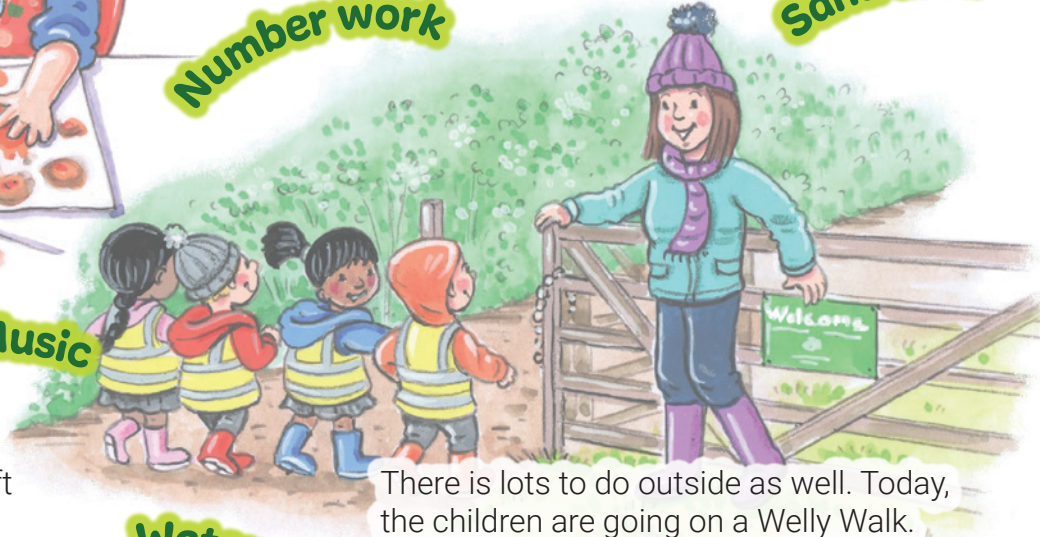

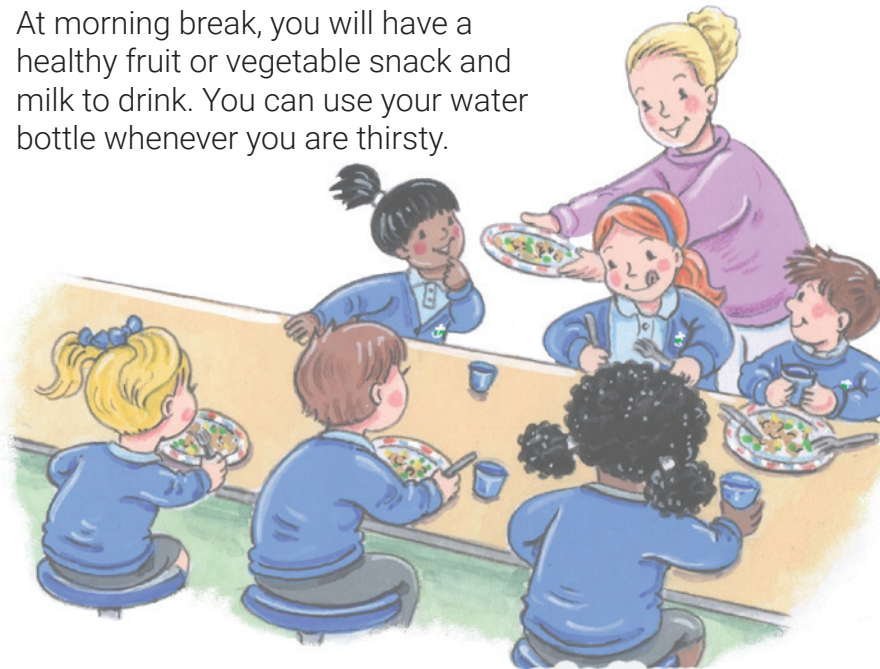


There is lots to do outside as well. Today, the children are going on a Welly Walk.
