He is going to ask his dad if they can read it at home.

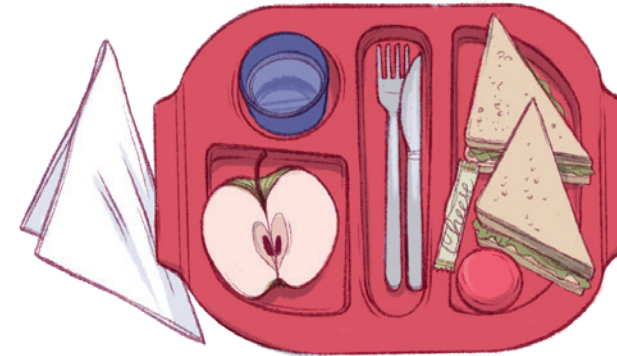
Now Arhsan and Tehila are outside at the mud kitchen.

Finn and Arshan have been to the toilet and used soap and warm water to clean their hands.

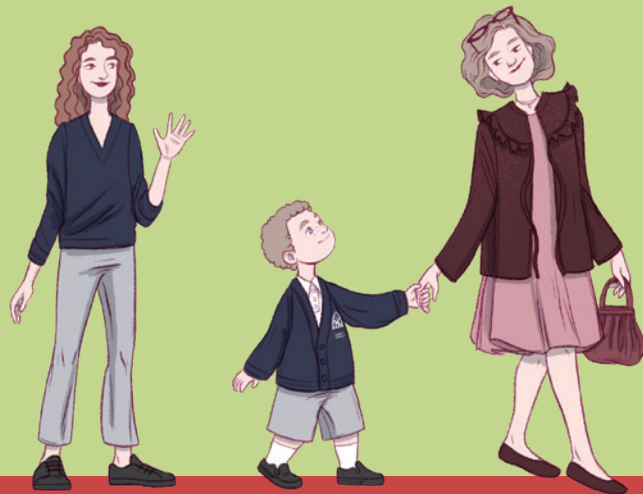
"I have got some paper towels so we can dry our hands," Finn says.
