After your activity, you will sit on the carpet and your teacher will tell you about all the brilliant things you are going to do that day.








# What will I do in Nursery?

You will learn as you play. Sometimes you will do an activity with your teacher, but most of the time you can choose what you do.


Faizal and his friend Mia are building a tower with the blocks.

You will start your day at school or Nursery with toast, yogurt and fruit.

At lunchtime, you will have a hot, healthy and tasty school meal.

"My meal looks delicious. I love lunchtime!" he says.

Everyone uses their knife and fork and is kind and helpful. There are lots of kind adults with you at lunchtime who will look after you.



What happens when I need the toilet?

You can go whenever you need to. Just remember to tell your teacher when you go.

When you get bigger, it is a good idea to try to just go at break and lunchtime.

The Nursery toilets lead off from the classroom and the Reception toilets are just outside the classroom.

You will go by yourself, so your grown-ups will make sure you have lots of practice before you come to Nursery or Reception. If you need help, don't worry. You can ask your teacher.

Obie has flushed and now he is washing his hands.

"Washing my hands with soap and water means I won't spread any germs," he says.
