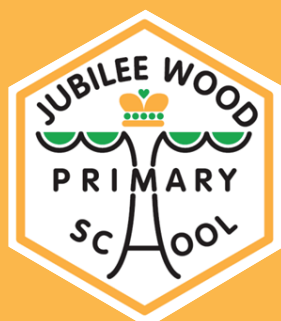
A love of reading
