


What happens when I come to nursery or school?

At lunchtime, you will go the hall where nursery and reception will be the only ones there.


If you are in reception, you will collect your knife and fork, find a space at the table and then go to get your meal.

Your grown-ups will have ordered your school meal for you. You can also bring a healthy packed lunch if you prefer to bring a meal from home.








What happens when I need to go to the toilet?

Rose is going to do some number work with her teacher.


"Before I do my number work, please can I go to the toilet?"
