What happens when I come to nursery or school?

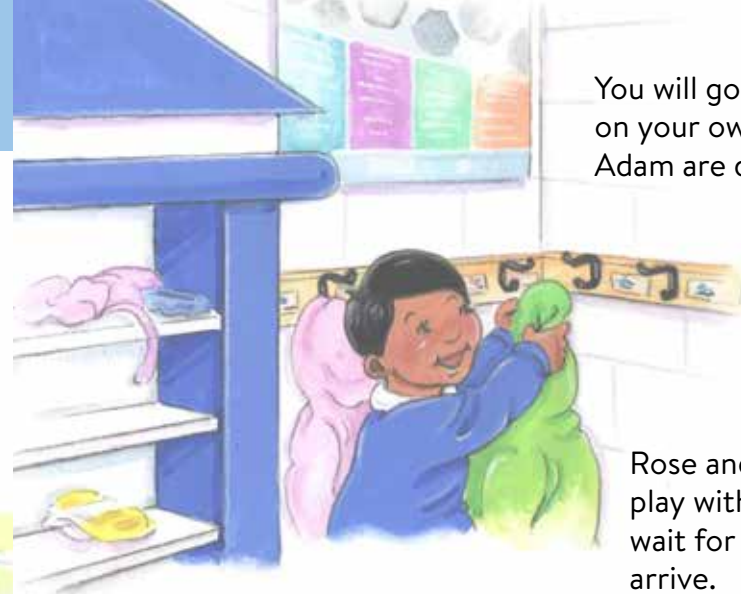


Your grown-up will bring you to the gates for nursery or reception next to the Children's Centre and say goodbye.

In nursery, you will have a snack in the afternoon too.

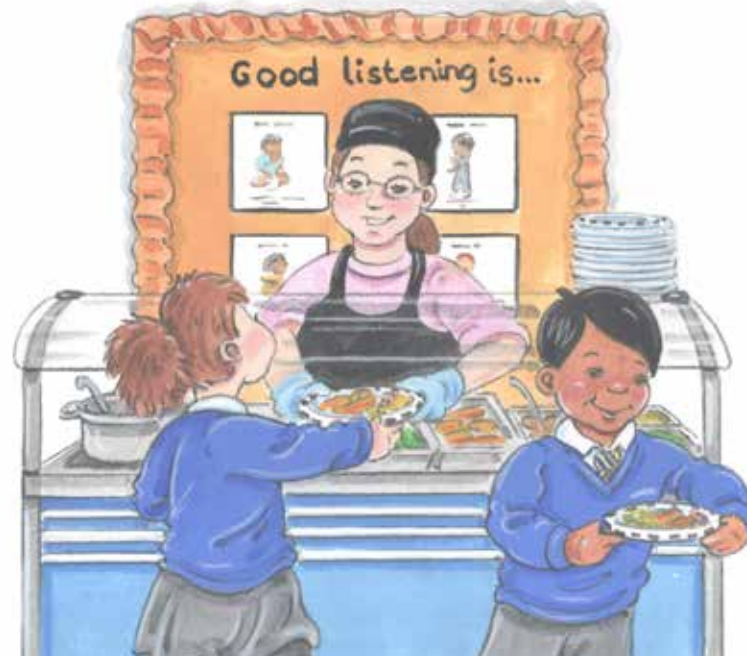


At lunchtime, you will go the hall where nursery and reception will be the only ones there.

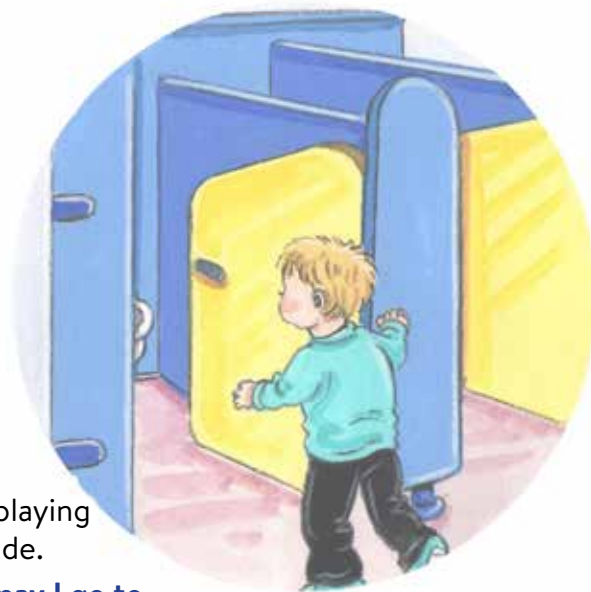
What happens when I need to go to the toilet?

on the slide.

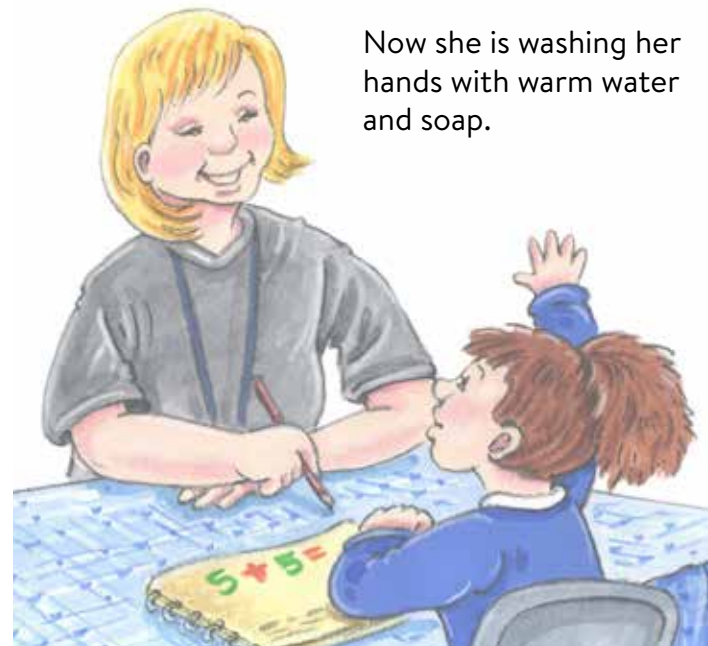
**“Please may I go to

the toilet in case he needs help.

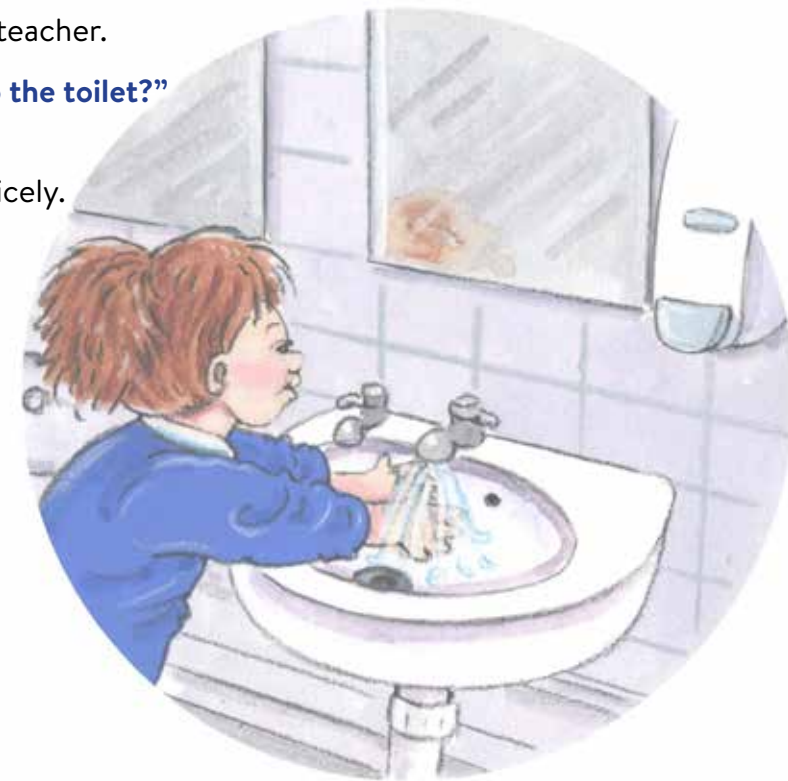
Rose is going to do some number work with her teacher.

When it is nearly home time, you will tidy up and sit on the carpet with your friends to sing songs or listen to a story.

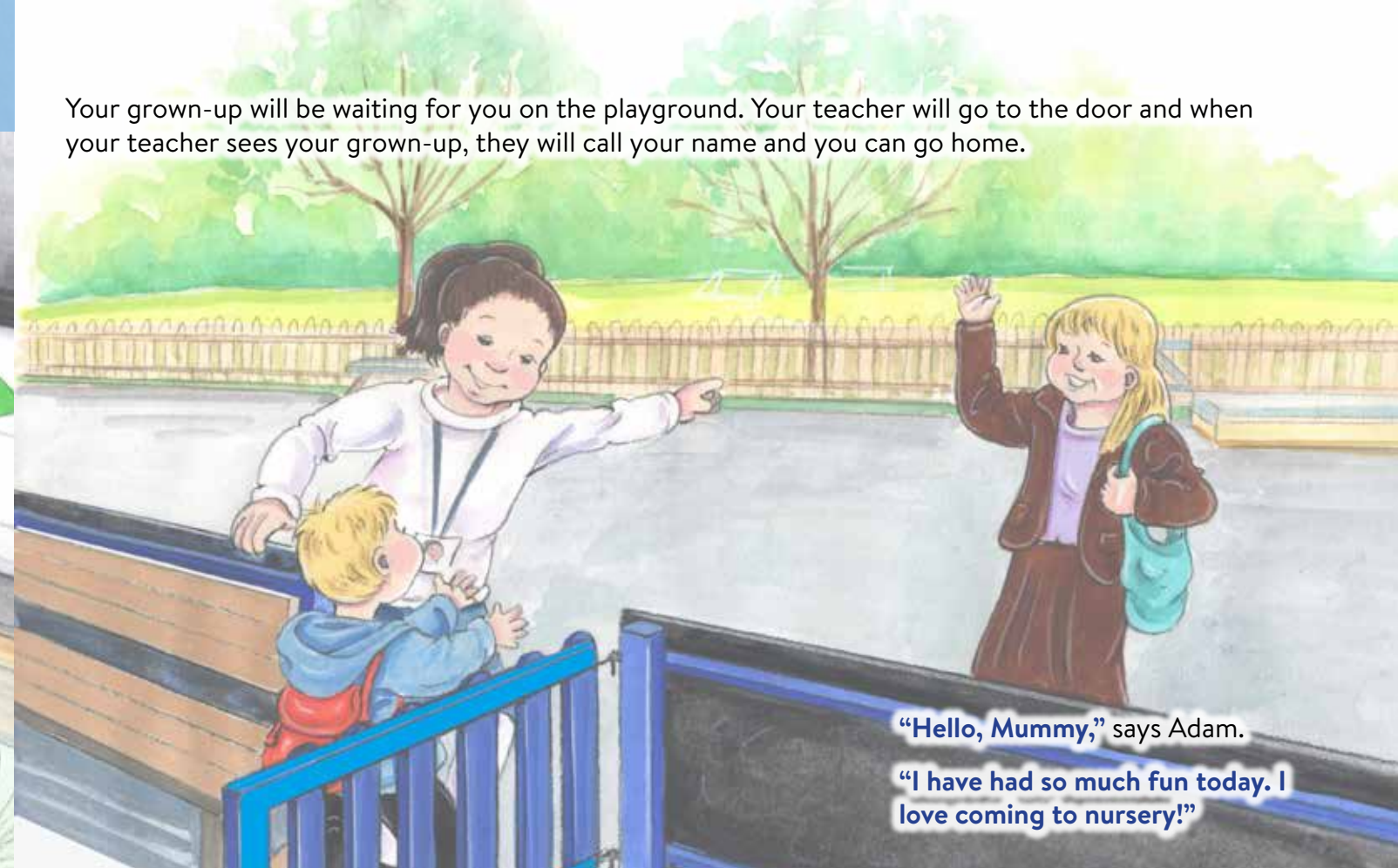


"I love this story,"
