The children are playing outside with the leaves.


“Let’s catch some leaves,” Noman says.

You will have a fruit snack and milk at break time. You can have a drink from your water bottle whenever you are thirsty.


At lunchtime, you will go to the hall for your meal. There will be lots of kind adults there to look after you.

What if I need the toilet?




You can go when you need to; just remember to tell your teacher.
