What happens when I come to school?




In the morning, your grown-up will bring you into school and take you to the double blue doors. A teacher will be waiting there to greet you and take you into school.

When you get inside, you will go through to the cloakroom area and find the peg with your name and special picture on it and hang up your coat.




After you have finished your activities, everyone sits on the carpet together for the register and to talk about all the fun and exciting things you and your friends will be doing that morning.

George has gone to play with his friend, Zara, in the Wendy house.


"Let's pretend this is a café," Zara says.

What happens when I need the toilet?


The toilets are near your classroom and your teacher will make sure you know where to find them. You can go to the toilet whenever you need to but ask your teacher first.

"Of course you can," replies the teacher. "Thank you for asking so nicely."




Can you use the toilet by yourself? 9

"I'll help you," says Arjan.






The children love story time. After story time you will collect your coat and belongings.


At home time, your teacher will call your name and you will go to meet your grown-up at the blue doors.
