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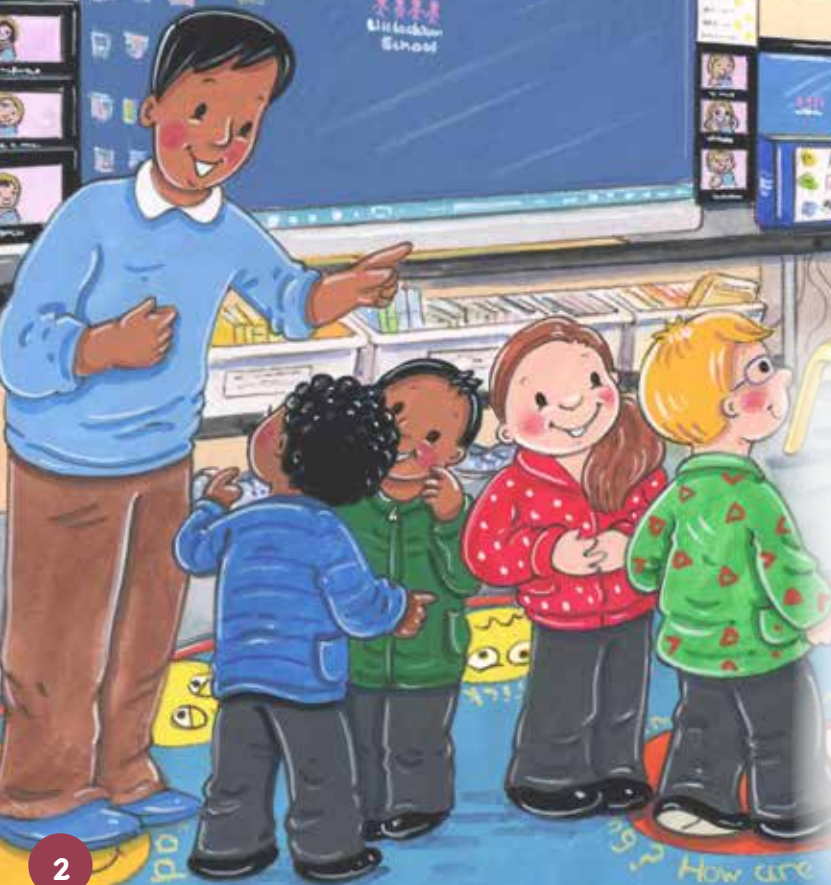


## Joining Shooting Stars at Littledown School

# What do I do when I get to Shooting Stars?

We will also teach you about computing, cooking and PSHE (Personal, Social and Health Education).

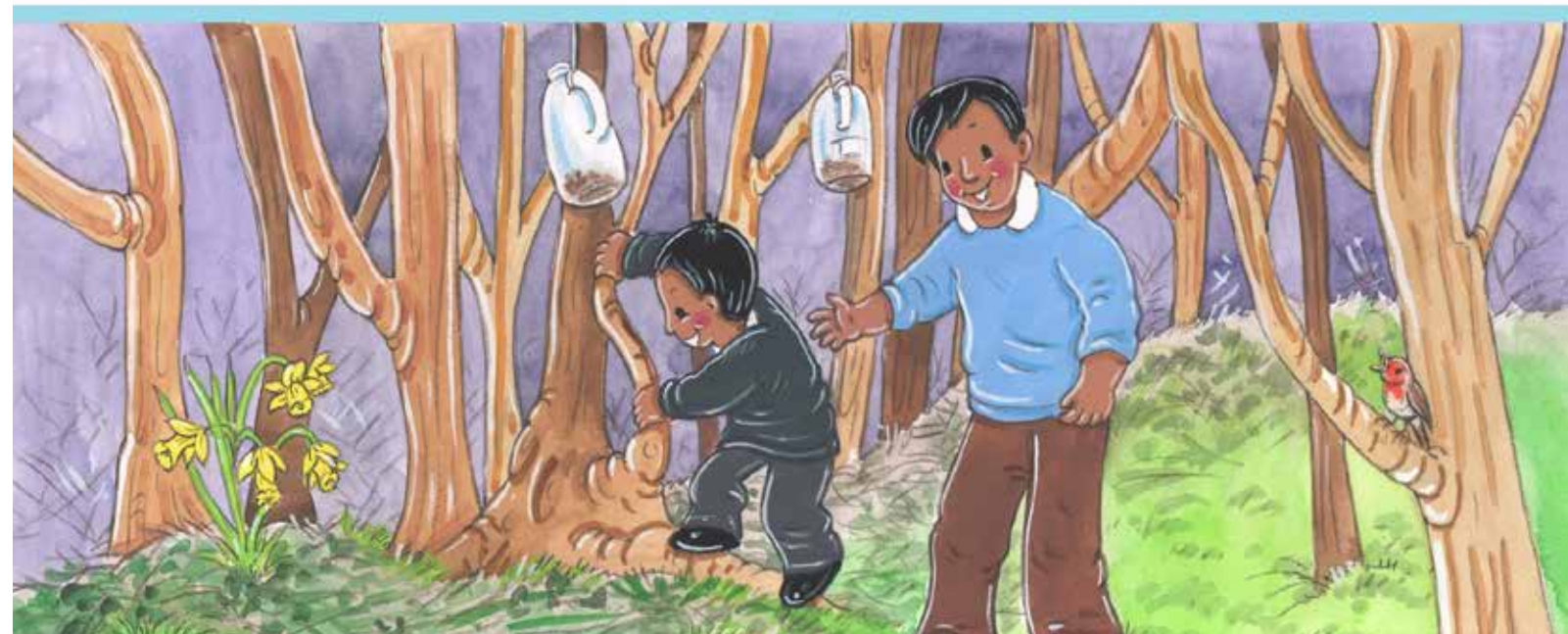
Ali and his new friend Millie are doing some cooking.
