Feroz and James are building a tower with blocks. "How high do you think we can build?" says James. "Taller than the teacher?"


"I would love to see a tower that tall," says Feroz.

What if I am hungry or thirsty?


You can have a drink whenever you are thirsty. Your teachers will make sure that there is always a drink ready for you with your name and photo.

Feroz and Sophie are having their drink together.




What if I need the toilet?




James is going to the toilet by himself.


"I think I will go into the blue toilet today because that is my favourite colour," he says.
