# What if I am hungry or thirsty?

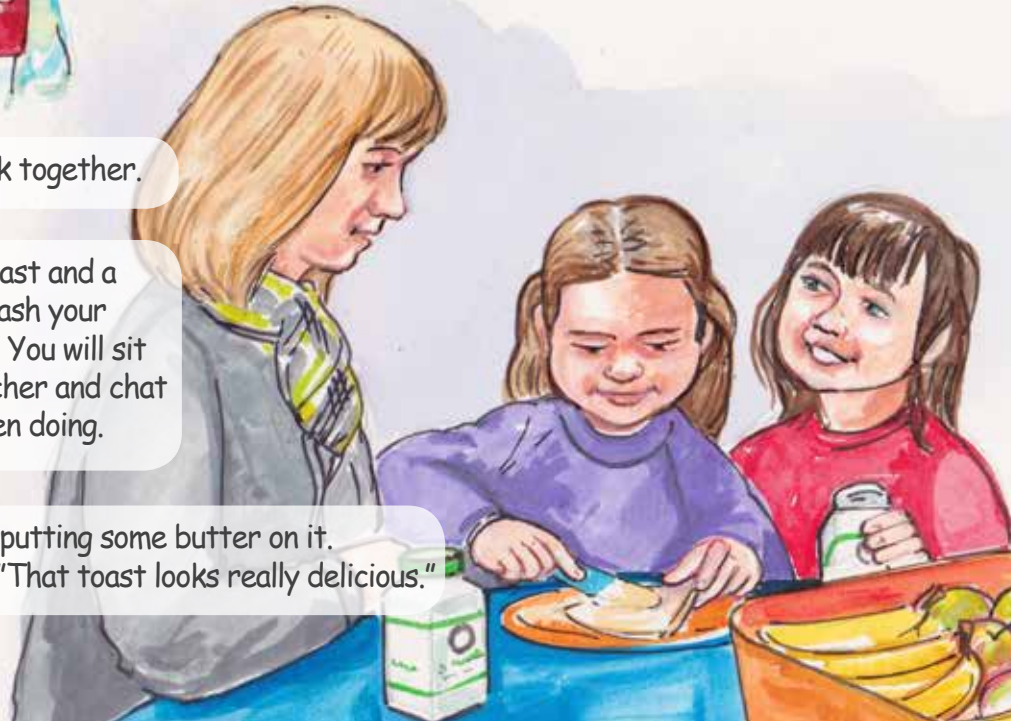


Feroz and Sophie are having their drink together.

# What if I need the toilet?
